On Behalf

"On Behalf of the Academy" were the closing words used by Dr. John W. Hoyt, first President and one of the principal founders, at the end of the fledgling organization's first Bulletin dated April 1870. Also above his signature was a "Plan of Operations" which was both ambitious and significant in its scope--calling for cooperation with the established State Agricultural Society and State Historical Society to perform a unique coordinating effect. He urged members to participate actively in affairs of the state related to their fields of research and scholarship and encouraged wealthy citizens to endow this effort with liberal support. The Arts and Letters were to have an important role with the Sciences in this plan, and an endowment of at least \$100,000 was to be invested to assure the means for a minimum of one full-time officer to administer Academy affairs.

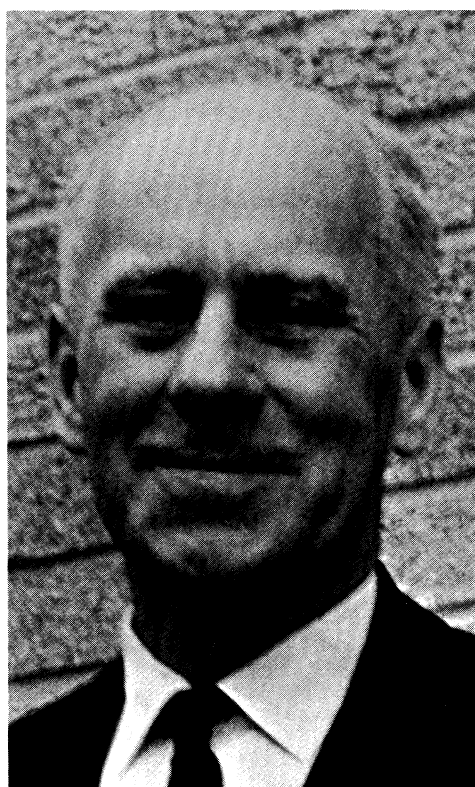

We now are preparing plans for a broad-gauged program at the Academy's 95th Anniversary Meeting to be held on the University of Wisconsin Madison campus next Spring with the theme, "The Role of the Sciences, Arts and Letters in Wisconsin History." Dr. Hoyt would be impressed if he were present to see the Academy's accomplishments over the years, but he also might be saddened by our failure to reach some of the high goals he visualized. True, time changes the needs and goals continually must be reviewed and renewed. It is the purpose of this brief message to make such inventory and appraisal with a view toward organization of a constructive program for the Wisconsin Academy in the 1964-65 year.

When he was President of the University of Wisconsin eleven years ago, E. B. Fred welcomed our 83rd annual meeting participants with his address on "The Wisconsin Idea and the Academy." He stated that "the Academy is a necessary organization for Wisconsin; it takes an extremely important part in the cultural and scientific life of the state. One of the unique contributions of the Academy is the way it brings together both humanists and scientists. . . . The Wisconsin Academy has played an important role in the life of Wisconsin and her people since it was founded in 1870. We are proud of Wisconsin and her accomplishments, and the Academy has had no small part in the attainments for which Wisconsin is known." He also extended a challenge to all of us to pioneer in finding the answers to many still unsolved and unknown facets of our complicated environment. It is of interest to note that the Academies of Michigan and Utah are the only others embracing the Arts and Letters as well as the Sciences. Herein lie our future opportunities and strength!

A review of the past decade reveals tremendous growth in membership, quality of publications and financial stability for the Wisconsin Academy. Messages from past-presidents and officers published in the Wisconsin Academy Review clearly indicate the problems faced and favorable results from hard work by many people. Among the most heartwarming of experiences was the response from members to a 1953 questionnaire regarding their willingness to help with participation in Academy activities and to help solve a temporary financial crisis with generous contributions. There is no question we are on our way toward the goal of 5,000 members by 1970 which was set by our immediate past-president.

Here are a few of the Wisconsin Academy's assets and accomplishments in the past decade, according to reports of previous presidents:

1. A strong Junior Academy of Science with 13 district and regional meetings throughout Wisconsin and Scholarship incentives at the Statewide Meeting.
2. Growth of membership better than 300% with all present members paying dues and non-active members dropped.
3. Annual meetings on specific themes since 1958 attracting hundreds of participants with greatly enhanced interest and quality.
4. Financial stability assured for continuation of routine Academy activities.
5. Academy library of 35,000-40,000 volumes housed with the University of Wisconsin Memorial Library in Madison increasing in quality and size continuously through annual TRANSACTIONS exchange program.
6. Establishment of quarterly Wisconsin Academy Review and improvement of size and quality of TRANSACTIONS including special supplements on annual meeting theme.
7. Affiliation with the American Association for the Advancement of Science for the past 44 years with fruitful results from this relationship.

In spite of all these encouraging developments, much good work within the scope of the Academy's Charter and field of responsibilities remains undone. To a large extent this failure can be laid to the lack of a full-time "Executive Secretary" who could help the elected officers with their duties. As the membership grows, this need becomes more acute both because of the routine administrative work load and the desirability of making use of the supply of talent available. Many members would like to participate in constructive projects of a research or scholarly nature but it has been impossible to organize such a program to date. Also, our Long-Range Program Committee has recommended special regional field meetings throughout the state but these have not materialized due largely to the planning and organizational effort. Financially, we still need a sufficient endowment to support a full-time paid administrator or some other dependable means of support until memberships are adequate to

carry the load. More funds for Junior Academy Scholarships and incentive awards for research in the Humanities are recommended by the Council.

Most encouraging is the fact that we are moving forward toward the year of 1970 and our Centennial Celebration. A committee to plan for this event has been activated and will get underway soon. All of the Academy's promotional efforts from now on should capitalize on this celebration and aim at broad participation and support with this in mind. Our Membership Committee already is doing wonders--as if by magic--and these favorable results must be continued and enhanced with much more public information coverage. The people of Wisconsin need to understand and appreciate the Academy's role in the life of the state so they will want to support it with their memberships and otherwise.

In 1870 the Wisconsin Legislature chartered the Academy "to encourage investigation and disseminate correct views of the various departments of science, literature and the arts." There are many specific objects listed in this charter which still are worthy of consideration. Of special interest is Section 5 of this Charter, which reads: "It shall be the duty of said Academy to keep a careful record of all its financial and other transactions, and, at the close of each fiscal year, the President thereof shall report the same to the Governor of the State, to be by him laid before the Legislature."

It is my desire, as President, to propose a plan to the Council for preparation and distribution of such a report--largely to include the recommendations of several ad hoc committees assigned to the study of special problems of concern to the state and the welfare of its people. It also is my hope that these investigations may include a continuation of some reconnaissance surveys similar to that done on the Brule River Watershed in the 1944-54 decade. As we more closely relate the Wisconsin Academy to the state's problems and help in their solution, so also we will deserve and receive much more support from the people.

I find that other Presidents before me often have made sound recommendations and strong resolutions for action only to find that time intervenes--both in terms of office and other personal commitments. Success is in relation to the effort put forth by the people committed to assist on the big job at hand. It is my hope to expand this number of individuals with assignments in order to make the Academy more effective and responsive to the needs faced by the people of Wisconsin which it was created to serve. I will welcome letters from any members who have suggestions in this regard or who wish to offer their assistance on such ad hoc committee assignments.

The Academy Council will meet at the Wisconsin Center in Madison on October 3, 1964 and it is my hope to present this plan of action in more detail then. Also, I plan to report on the results of a survey of the activities and financial backing of all other State Academies which reply to my questionnaire by that date. We need to evaluate our results in the light of what other similar organizations are doing in order to improve our own program. This is your Wisconsin Academy and I will need help from all of you if we are to do the job before us this year.

COUNCIL MEETING
February 8, 1964

MINUTES

Present: Henry C. Ahrnsbrak, Jack R. Arndt, David J. Behling, Goodwin F. Berquist, Harry Hayden Clark, Robert J. Dicke, Merrit Y. Hughes, Aaron J. Ihde, Otto L. Kowalke, Ted J. McLaughlin, Katherine G. Nelson, Eugene M. Roark, H. A. Schuette, Walter E. Scott, Roy D. Shenefelt, and Carl Welty.

The meeting was called to order at 10:05 a.m. at the Wisconsin Center in Madison, President Ihde presiding.

1. The minutes of the Council meeting of November 2, 1963 were approved.

2. The Financial Report, as given by Treasurer Behling, was approved. It shows assets of \$6,727.77, an endowment fund balance of \$3,670.82, and accounts receivable of approximately \$1,000.00. The Academy has no outstanding liabilities. Special note was given to three new Life Memberships (Elmer Strehlow, Dr. Hazel S. Alberson, and Mr. and Mrs. Carl F. Steiger) and to gifts of \$2,500 from Dr. Harry Steenbock and \$50 from C. M. Goethe.

Mr. Behling intends to repay a portion of the general fund "debt" to the endowment fund. The three Life Memberships will be placed in the endowment fund, as well. The matter of a separate account for the Junior Academy, raised by Mr. Arndt, will be taken under advisement.

3. New memberships approved included the three Life Memberships listed above plus 6 Active Memberships and 3 Student Memberships.

Total membership in the Academy is now - Life 47, Sustaining 37, Active 868, Library 95, Student 24, and Honorary 3.

4. The Transactions should be ready for distribution in March. The new style sheet and editorial policy will now go into effect. The Urbanism monograph, which cost \$1700 to publish, has been on sale at the University bookstore in Milwaukee; 104 copies have been sold at \$2.50 each, and there are 196 left. Mr. Berquist suggested that if the Academy wishes to publish a monograph on the 1964 Annual Meeting, a sponsor should be sought, as the cost will probably be greater. Mr. Scott agreed to try to locate a sponsor or sponsors, and the Council approved publication if he is successful.

5. The Fall, 1963 Review is in preparation. Mr. Scott reported that completion of the 10-year index is the major task remaining. No successor to Mr. Scott has been found. If Professor Peterson of Milwaukee-Downer College is willing and able to accept the position, his appointment is approved.

6. The 1962-1963 Annual Review of the Junior Academy was distributed, as well as an Academy newsletter. Membership is growing at the rate of 25 to 30 per year. John D. Wasserstrass, Monroe, was sent as a delegate to the AAAS meeting.

7. The Librarian, Mr. Shenefelt, reported sale of excess Transactions to book dealer Paul Askins of Madison for \$125. Mr. Arndt has sent 41 full sets to high school libraries.

8. Program Chairman, Scott, reported acceptances from several invited speakers for the Annual Meeting. Several new memberships have come in as a result. The first publicity material has gone out, with more to follow.

Various details of the local arrangements were discussed by Mr. Ahrnsbrak. Materials to be mailed to all members will go out in March. Reservations should be made before April 15.

9. Mrs. Nelson, reporting for the Long Range Program Committee, discussed steps the Academy should take to further the objectives and implement the functions listed in our Constitution. She suggested that efforts should be made to bring more linguists into the Academy, and to encourage philological research. In order to honor outstanding work by artists, writers and scientists, this Committee suggests the establishment of a Citations Committee representing the three areas. This suggestion was approved, and President Ihde subsequently appointed the three Vice-Presidents, Mr. Behling, Helen White, and John Thompson to serve on this Committee under Chairman Carl Welty. This will be a continuing program, to honor either individuals or organizations, with the Council ruling on Committee recommendations. The publicity value of such action was stressed. The Committee also feels that our AAAS delegate should attend AAAS meetings and the Academy conference, at our expense.

Mr. Dicke urged that the Committee organize a fall meeting as soon as it is feasible. This suggestion, too, was approved.

10. Mr. Clark discussed the possibility of grants by industry for work in the humanities which could then be published in the Transactions. He will follow through on the matter.

11. Since the Great Hall of the Union is not available on May 1 for the 1965 Annual Meeting, President Ihde will try to arrange for the necessary facilities for May 7 and 8, 1965.

12. Alternative uses of the Steenbock gift were discussed. A membership drive seemed to be one activity which Dr. Steenbock considered worthwhile, and various methods of conducting such a drive were suggested. Another activity in which Dr. Steenbock expressed interest was the Junior Academy. Approval was given for placing \$1000 in the Junior Academy fund, \$1000 in a membership drive, and \$500 in reserve. The Junior Academy funds would probably be used for awards, scholarships, publications or symposia. Special Patron Membership status was awarded Dr. Steenbock in recognition of his generous support.

13. President Ihde will look into the manner in which Academy-owned library material is marked, stored, and handled at the University Library.

14. The next meeting of the Council will be held in Wausau on May 1.

The meeting was adjourned at 2:13 p.m.

COUNCIL MEETING

May 1, 1964

MINUTES

Present: Allen Abrams, Jack R. Arndt, David J. Behling, Goodwin F. Berquist, Harry Hayden Clark, Stephen F. Darling, Merrit Y. Hughes, Aaron J. Ihde, Henry A. Meyer, Ted J. McLaughlin, Katherine G. Nelson, Eugene M. Roark, and Walter E. Scott. Also present were Gene Musolf and J. J. Chopp.

The meeting was called to order at 3:00 p.m. at the University of Wisconsin Extension Center in Wausau, President Ihde presiding.

1. The minutes of the Council meeting of February 8, 1964 were read and approved as corrected. The corrections are: in item 4, substitute "was announced" for "will now go into effect;" in item 7, substitute "Askin" for "Askins;" in item 8, substitute "Ahrnsbrak" for "Ahrnsbrak."

2. The Treasurer's Report, as given by Mr. Behling, was approved. Membership receipts for the period April 24, 1963 through April 15, 1964 totaled \$4,594, and there were contributions of \$4,200. Total income of \$9,465.77, together with \$4,363.53 carried forward on April 24, 1963, constitute receipts of \$13,829.30.

Disbursements during this period add up to \$6,295.07, leaving a balance on hand as of April 15, 1964, of \$7,534.23. Mr. Behling pointed out that while this represents a considerable improvement over the balance of \$4,363.53 one year ago, there have been a number of large bills presented since the books were closed. He commented, however, that the Academy is in fine financial condition. Repayment of a portion of the General Fund's "debt" to the Endowment Fund will follow payment of all bills outstanding.

A total budget of \$9,500 was approved. This compares to \$8,700 one year ago. Increases for Administration and Junior Academy were authorized.

3. New memberships approved included a Life Membership for Gordon A. Bubolz of Appleton, and 54 other memberships in various categories.

With 55 new memberships since February, and 25 cancellations, total membership in the Academy has now reached 1104.

4. Mr. Berquist, Transactions editor, discussed the new "pay-as-you-go" reprint policy, the "windfall" of 245 over-run copies of the 1963 volume, changes in format and design, plans for 1964, and the new editorial policy. He revealed that expenses (\$5,625.25) for the current volume were more than covered by income (\$5,738.00) during the same period. "Income", of course, includes the Transactions budget set by the Council.

5. The appointment of Mr. Arndt as Review editor, to succeed Mr. Scott, was approved. Mr. and Mrs. Scott have agreed to assist with the editorial work.

The purchase of a "varitype" typewriter for Review preparation was approved. It is anticipated that the new style of type, with even lines and margins, will facilitate efforts to obtain second-class mailing privileges; a considerable saving would be effected if this were possible.

6. Mr. Arndt, in his capacity as Director of the Junior Academy, reported that the program as a whole continues to gain strength each year. Junior papers will be published in the forthcoming Review. At the present time, Senior High School district Meetings and Junior High School regional meetings are in progress.

7. Mr. Scott, Chairman of the Annual Program Committee, said that he expects the meeting and program to run about as planned, except for one participant who had been forced to withdraw. He had already received \$117.00 in orders for the anticipated publication of the meeting proceedings. Several past presidents, invited to attend and be especially recognized at the banquet, had sent regrets, and Mr. Noland and Mr. Buckstaff had sent contributions for the Endowment Fund.

Mr. Musolf, reporting as Chairman of the Local Arrangements Committee, said he expected a total attendance of about 250, with 200 at the luncheon, 160 at the banquet, and 75 on the field trip and picnic.

8. On behalf of the Long-Range Program Planning Committee, Mrs. Nelson discussed locations which have been proposed or determined for future meetings. The Academy will meet in Madison in 1965, in Oshkosh in 1967, and again in Madison for the centennial meeting in 1970. Lawrence College in Appleton has invited the Academy there in 1966, and Mr. Ihde relayed an invitation from Eau Claire State College for the same year. Acceptance of the Lawrence invitation was voted, and if Eau Claire State will renew their invitation for 1968, it will be accepted, too. Mr. Chopp issued an invitation to meet at Whitewater State College in 1969, and this, too, was accepted. Mr. Hughes suggested that the Academy should seek a meeting in Superior for 1971, to further our growth and participation in the northern part of Wisconsin.

9. Mr. Chopp was congratulated on his fine work as Chairman of the Membership Committee. He suggested that a sub-committee of membership representatives from various colleges, universities, agencies and even companies be appointed to work for continued growth in Academy strength. Such action, it was felt, would be a prerogative of the Membership Committee.

10. Resolutions thanking the Director and Faculty of the Marathon County Extension Center for their cooperation, commending Academy officers and committee chairmen for their work on the Annual Meeting, and commemorating deceased members were read by Mr. McLaughlin. These were to be introduced for action at the Annual Business Meeting on May 2, 1964.

11. Mr. Hughes, acting for Nominations Committee Chairman Klotsche, read the list of nominations for 1964-65 officers to be elected on May 2, 1964 at the Annual Business Meeting.

12. Mr. Scott indicated that he plans to keep the same people active on the Centennial Planning Committee, if possible, and meet with them soon.

13. Free distribution of Review numbers which are available in excessive supply, to selected Wisconsin libraries and at this meeting, was approved.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:30 p.m.

ANNUAL MEETING
May 2, 1964
MINUTES

The meeting was convened at 4:45 p.m. in Room 213 of the Marathon County Extension Center, University of Wisconsin, in Wausau, President Ihde presiding. Twenty-one members of the Academy were present.

1. The minutes of the Ninety-third Annual Business Meeting on May 4, 1963, were approved after correction of the name of one deceased member; E. Errington is incorrect and the first initial should be P., in the Memorial Resolution.

2. The Treasurer's Report was distributed, briefly discussed, and approved.

3. Mr. Roark, reporting for Membership Chairman Chopp, reported on growth in Academy membership and plans for further membership efforts. Funds contributed to the Academy by Dr. Harry Steenbock will be utilized in part for this campaign.

4. Transactions Editor Berquist discussed plans for the next volume, the new design changes and reprint policy, and financing.

5. Review Editor Scott expressed confidence in Mr. Arndt, the new editor, and asked that everyone extend to him their assistance and cooperation. Mr. Scott thanked Academy members for their support over the ten-year period of Review publication, and especially thanked Mr. Fred Logan and Mr. McCanse.

6. President Ihde, reporting for Mr. Arndt, described continued progress and achievement in the Junior Academy program.

7. Mrs. Nelson listed locations for future Academy Meetings, as follows, and as selected by the Long-Range Planning Committee:

8. Resolutions Committee Chairman McLaughlin introduced the following resolutions and moved their adoption, which was unanimously approved:

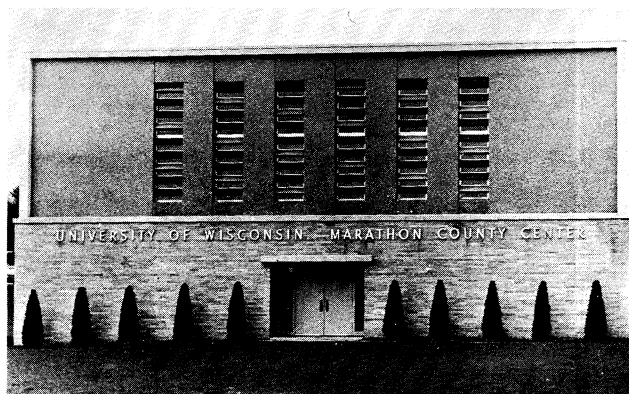

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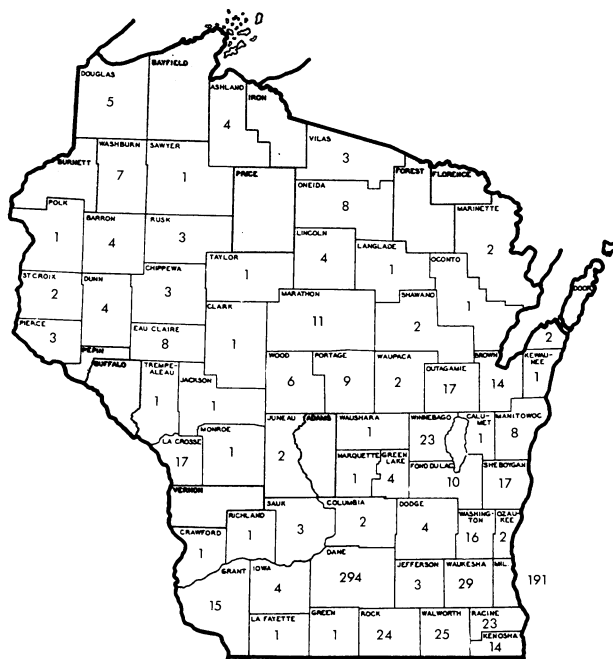

(Neither the map nor the figures given above reflect the nearly 100 Academy memberships received since April 30, 1964.)
