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

1900 -

Friday Nov. 16 -

This has been one of
the most beautiful of days
again and Aunt Burns
after your nap took us
for a nice long ride.

We drove around in
the City and you seemed
to enjoy it more than
I can say. At first
you thought you did
not care to go but
Mama persuaded you
to stick you needed
it and as you are such
a sensible little maid
you concluded to go -
I know it did you lots
of good.

Saturday M. 17 -

This has been such a lovely day too and my little ones have been outside some too.

This forenoon Blanche came and played a little while with you and then you put on your maps and went out - a took a ride or two down the hill with the girls.

Then after your nap you and brother and Mama went over to Aunt Bassins and took our supper with them.

Sunday Nov. 18 -

This has been a big day
for my little girl. Just
the day you did seem
to want. Your Papa
took you to Sunday School
and the Uncle Herman
and Aunt Bertha came
down and took dinner
with us. You did
enjoy their fun so
much. You of course
did not take a nap
and had lots of fun
from beginning to end.

Mama does love
to see you have a good
time though you
must be very tired.

Monday Nov. 19 -

Today it made it
rather bad my little
ones could not go out
any for it ruined all
of the day. But you
took a good nap after
dinner and after that
you helped Mama do
some work she had
to do about decorating
a room in white for
you and then after
supper Papa stayed at
home with us and
this you did enjoy
more than I can
say. You always tell
him to come home
early -

Tuesday Nov. 20 -

This forenoon was not-
at all pleasant and
it rained more than
half the time. But-
after your nap it was
much pleasanter and
Helen and Maria came
and you were ready
for fun. You and
the babies just ran
from one end of the
yard to the other and
had a big time.

It does you lots of
good to get out these
days and Mama
loves to have you

Wednesday Nov. 2 -

This is a very pleasant day again and my little ones have been out some. Blanche came over this forenoon and you little ones were out more or less.

Then this afternoon Aunt-Bessie took us out for a drive. She took us over to the farm and we did not get home until rather late. You were happy all the time we were out and seemed to enjoy it very much.

Thursday Nov. 22 -

This morning my little
men were outside
playing in the sand
for a little time
while Aunt-Bessie and
Mama made some
candy. Then after
you map this afternoon
Mama took you
up town to meet-

Papa and walk home
to supper with him.

You enjoyed it and it
did you good as well
as Mama -

You looked and were
tired tonight at bed time

Friday Nov. 23 -

This forenoon my
little ones did go
outside soon but not
much for it was
rather too cold. Uncle
Human came here to
dinner and this you
did like very much.

You did not get to
sleep until rather
late this afternoon
so slept later than
usual. Then we went
up town to meet
Papa and your brothers
it being as before -
You are so well and
very happy.

Saturday Nov. 24 -

You had a good time
this forenoon. You
and brother went over
and played with
Blanchin for a little
while and then after
your nap, your little
friend Margery came
over and you did have
a big time. Russell
was a happy one it-
as you were and it
did me good
to see you so happy.
Then after your bath
you were too tired
little ones -

Sunday Nov. 25 -

This has been another
lovely Sunday. You and
Papa went out to Sunday
School today, and
then after shopping
affection together you
walked. Mama out for
a long walk. We
walked as far as the
mission bridge and
then back. It made
us very hungry and
tired. Then you
and I have had
another night - your
parade and next
to bed happy.

Monday Nov 26 -

Saturday night - You and
Mama made an engagement
with a little lady friend
of yours that - you would
attend school with her
this day and at eight-
o'clock this morning. We
never thought about it - and
when she came home
did hurry and comb those
curls and dress. You did
not get her late either and
after dinner you went
again. It was a catholic
school and when you
came home you asked
Mama whether those ladies
there had no hair on their
heads because they wore
a idle cloth over it all day.
You innocent little sweet;

and you said they
asked you whether you
liked ladies like them
and you said yes -

You were very good
all day and brought
home two little pictures
for good behavior and
were asked by the sisters
to come again - You
came home very
hungry and we glad
to get some thing to
eat - night - away. You
are a dear and Mama
loves you much. You
have taken a notion to
sleep with Mama lately
and ask Mama every
night not to let Papa take
you into his bed when you are
asleep -

Tuesday M^r. 21-

This forenoon we & your
little girl friends came
over to play with you
and you had a good
time. Then after dinner
you took a long nap
from me until four
so that you could go
out with Mama tonight
and feel good. You saw
the Passion Play, there
on a canvas of enormous
size and you knew of
the story of Jesus before
and you were delighted.
You talked of nothing
else today. You exclaimed
once right out in church.
"Oh where is Jesus Mama?"

Wednesday Nov. 28 -

You and brother dinner
and went over to get
one of your little friends
to come and play with
you. She came and you
had a big time. One
of your little gentleman
friends made an
engagement with Mama
over the phone to take
you to school this
afternoon. You went ~~and~~
he brought you home
and said you had been
a good girl. You were
exceptionally tired though.
Mama put you to bed
early and you will
feel better in the morning
sure I know -

Thursday Nov. 29 -

Well my little girl had a big day of it today. Your Uncle Frank Volkner came early this Thanksgiving morning and took you and Walter out for a long morning ride in your car. Then you had a big time helping Mama get the big dinner. You then spent a little time with us at Uncle Harry's where Grandma and Grandpa were and with whom we all drove home and had a lovely ride over and back. After tea you sat and brushed your Papa's hair while Mama played and sang for a while then reading a good Thanksgiving story and went to bed.

Friday Nov. 30 -

This has been another
very lonely day and this
morning you and brother
Started out for a little
walk over to the neighbors.

You were gone about
one hour and a half and
when you came back had
brought two little friends
with you, then after you
had a good play you
had your dinner and
then your nap. You
then asked Mama to
tell you lots of stories
which I did and you
seemed quite happy
about them and had
quite a longing struck
after it was all over -

Saturday Dec 1 -
1906

This has been one of
nature's loveliest days and
we have enjoyed it so
much. You may little
one could not endure
it. An other minute after
ten o'clock this morning
without one of your
little friends to play
with you so you
started out with your
little brother on your arm.

You brought little
Edward Haight over and
such real good fun as
you did have. Then this
afternoon often your
map you started over to
one of the neighbors for
a little while.

Sunday Dec 2 -

This has been a very
very happy day for
my little girl. You and
Mama went to church
while Farrell and Papa
waited at the shop for
us then we all took a
walk home and soon
came back to the church
to practice for Xmas.

You are to take part this
year for the first time.
Mama almost dreads
to think of it too.

It just makes me
about sick to think my
little Maid is growing
so fast. Your a dear
little girl though -

Monday Dec 3 -

Yesterday being such a hard busy day for my little girl she did not feel much like doing much today. This forenoon you and brother played very nicely together and then this afternoon you could not get to sleep for you were simply too tired.

At four o'clock Mamma put you both into your cab and took you down to the church to practice for a social for Friday night. You are to be in your first tableau. You are in silent prayer. And it's very cute too.

Tuesday Dec. 4 -

This has not been
a pleasant day at all.
Mama could not let
her little ones go out to
play or walk either over.
It was so very damp
after your nap and Mama
had down a little painting
we were going out for
a walk when we found
it was raining quite
hard so we returned and
Mama read stories to
you both instead.

You were quite disappointed
but feel badly for Mama
too for you feared I was
feeling hurt about it.

You are a very thoughtful
little one Mama thinks.

Wednesday Dec 5 - -

This forenoon you did
have a big time with one
of your favorite little
friends playing in your
playroom. Then very
soon after dinner Mama
put you to bed and you
took a good nap but- if
you opened your eyes you
did beg Mama to take
you out for a drive.

This I did and we
went down to see Papa.

He wanted us to take
our tea up town with
him. We did and your
little ones thought it fine.
Then Uncle Frank came
up and spent the evening
with us and that was bus-

Thursday Dec 6 -

It has been a
very lovely day only
very cold. My little
Maid did not go out any.
Your little brother had
such a bad day as he
has a terrible cold. You
have felt very sorry
for him and have
done lots to amuse him
too. Mamma loves to
see you little ones think
so much of one another.
You are very happy in
such other company.
We had lots of fun together
even if brother could
not soon in and keep well.

Friday Dec 7-

This morning you did
try to go outside for a
little time. You did
not stay very long as
Mama thought best you
should not. You have
been looking forward
all day to going out
tonight to a little social
trial your little infant-
class given to their parents.
You all did very nicely
and Mama was glad
she took you. You had
a nice hour with Mrs.
Cull and then you
were quite happy.
You were delighted with
it all.

Saturday Dec. 8 -

This has been a very
showy day and Mamma
did let you put on your
raps and take a walk
over to the neighbor to take
a dolly house that belongs
there. You came home
quite early and thought
you would find Uncle
Fay Thompson here for
we are looking for him
this now. You were
not disappointed and he
was glad to see you
and you were him. You
put your arms around
his neck and gave him
a good hearty kiss.

Sunday Dec 9 -

This has been a hand
busy day for us all.

My little ones had
their pictures taken
this morning and such
a time as we did have.

We took this day for
it as we dreaded taking
a sick day as Papa
could not help us -

They were all quite good
too. Then this short
afternoon we spent together.

We read, ate candy
popcorn and apples around
our library fire. We
had jolly good times
together. Then we went
early to bed.

Monday Dec. 10 -

This has been a very cold, raw day and my little ones could not go out much. Though you did go out and walk up and down the walks a few times about four o'clock. Then Aunt Barbara surprised us by coming in to tea with us today; you did enjoy that. The proofs of your pictures came today and they were just fine. Mama and Papa were both very much delighted with them.

Tuesday Dec 11 -

This has been another
very busy day for Maria
and for my little girl
too. You had to go and
shear your little puse
for & miss with the other
little ones this morning
and then Maria had
several other engagements
beside. Her Aunt -
Bridget came and stayed
with the baby while we
were gone and also to
dinner which did please
you more than a little.
Blanchie came over
this afternoon and you
had a big day all round.

Ardmore day Dec 12 -

This forenoon Mama
had several engagements
up town so that my
little Son and brother
had to go over and
stay with Aunt Bessie.
You report a most lonely
time and Mama is
glad you could be there.

We were made to feel
very bad, and sad this
morning for we found
little Dickie dead in
his cage this morning.

He has been with us
ever since you had my
little one. He came just
a month before you did. You
and we all will miss him.

Thursday Dec 13 -

It has not been very pleasant out and my little Russell has not been out all day, but you my little maid took the bus and went up to Mrs. Smith all alone this morning. You did not seem to think you had done anything out of the ordinary and came home all right.

You went to practice with the other little ones for your Xmas program. Your brother missed you very much. Uncle Herman comes to stay all night and you are mighty delighted.

Friday Dec 14.

This morning my little maid became rather tired of staying home I guess so you would go over and spend a little time at Blanshie

You came home and said you had seen Papa come and wanted to come too. Then after you map you and brother had a good time until Uncle Truman came home from school. This evening Mama left you with Papa and went to an entertainment. We all had a good time,

Saturday Dec 15 -

It has been very cold all day. You were wide all the forenoon.

Then after your nap after dinner we took a walk up to Aunt Camis. You and Helen had a big time while Maria and Austin were out. Then you had a good ride home in the night-air.

You went to bed early and very tired too.

It does you so much good to get out only for a short time.

Sunday Dec 16 -

It has been a most
beautiful day and my
little girl has had a
very hard day of it - too

You went to church ^{and}
Sunday School with Papa
this morning and then
after dinner you had to
go up to practice for ~~you~~
again in the afternoon.

You went with a
little friend and you
had a good time. Mama
felt worried for you
did not get home for
so long a time in
the evening.

Monday Dec 17 -

You were at home
all day today. You
were not as good
naturied as usual and
I think it was because
you did not get your
good rest last night.

You have not been
outside today but you
did enjoy our company
this forenoon. You have
been very tired as usual
and have gone to
your little beds rather
early for my little
ones -

Tuesday Dec-18 -
1800

This has been another
very unpleasant day
and my little ones
have not been outside
except as you played
in the yard. You did
go over to Aunt-Bessie's
for a little time this
forenoon and play
with her big doll.

This was great fun
for you and Mama
loves to see you have
such good times. You
can scarcely wait
for Xmas to come and
neither can Mama
our preparations are going

Wednesday Dec 19 -

You have had such
lots of fun today
for you have been
outside and never
played in the sand or
you do in the summer
time. Then this afternoon
Aunt Bessie took us
all out for a lorry
drive and we came
in just feeling fine.
You ate a good
supper after walking
down and back and
then went to bed and
had a good rest.

Thursday Dec 20 -

This has been another
lovely day for little
children. You and
brother have been
outside most of the
day. You have played
as you would in
the summer time.
Then after your
nap Aunt Bessie
took you both and
Mama out for a
long ride. We came
in feeling much
refreshed, and it did
us all lots of good.

Friday Dec 21 -

Today my little dear
did not feel very
well. You came down
with a very bad
chill this afternoon
and after it came a
very bad fever of
which you have not-
recovered and are
growing worse all of
the time. Uncle Frank
came in and spent
the evening with us
and this you did
enjoy so very much.
Papa came home early to
his little sick Santa

Saturday Dec 22 -

all of today you have
been slightly uneasy
still with a high
fever. It makes
Mama about sick
herself to see her
dear little Son so
very sick - Mama
feels it much better
to be the sick one.

About six o'clock
tonight you wanted
your cloths on and
walk a little but
you find yourself
very much weaker
than you thought.

Sunday Dec 23 -

This morning my
little one got up feeling
much better than
you have for a few
days but you could
not stay awake long
before taking a nap
then you soon came
back and I think you
have about as much
as ever again. It
makes us all almost
unable to think it is so,
Your Uncle Fred came
from New York last
night and you are
very anxious to see
him too.

Monday Dec 24 - 1900

You feel if anything
worse today and Mama
sent for a doctor for
you early this morning
so that you play with
your gifts tomorrow and
have a little fun perhaps
on Xmas day. This
morning and afternoon Uncle
Fred came in to see
you and you did enjoy
him too though you
said he did not look
very natural to you.
This evening quite a
number of your Xmas
friends came in to
you and among them
is a doll from Miss Cull
this did please you.

1800

Tuesday Dec 25 -

When you came down
stair this morning and
saw all the things and
a tree too you nearly
had a fit. You were
not strong enough to
make as much of it
as you otherwise would
but when you saw two
new dolls and so many
other things you were a
happy girl. You did
play after your naps and
in the evening Uncle Fred
brought down his son whom
that he gave Grandma
and he was more
than happy to see you
and both crying it.

Wednesday Dec 28 -

Today you did play
more than yesterday
and had lots of fun
too. Uncle Fred came
in to Supper and you
had lots of fun with
him today. You were
so sorry to see him
go and so we all were.
We would all have
kept him longer had
it been a possible
thing. You seem very
much better today and
Mama is very happy
about it, even though
brother does not feel
so well.

Thursday Dec 27-

This has been a
very happy day for
you and Mama.
enjoyed it. too with
you for so many of
your little friends were
here to see your new
tree and things. You
all had a big time
together and hours
to see you enjoy your
new things so much.
The box from Reed City
came today and such
fun as it was to
unpack it. too. You
helped as much as you
could -

Friday, Dec 28 -

Today little brother
does not feel very
well, but you hope
will soon be better -
After dinner today
Aunt-Carrie came
down to see our tree
and our Xmas -

It was fine she
thought. It did you
good to think Aunt-
Carrie would come to
see your tree and
things. You showed
me many things you
had and could find.
She enjoyed it too.

Saturday Dec 27-

This has been a very
lovely day but my
little ones were not
feeling any too well
and Warren had lots
to do so we all stayed
in quite closely.

It did us all good
too for we have been
quite tired since Xmas.

You and brother
played long and
hard and then we
other little ones in
to help you out - too
Then you slept very
well too and never up
until -

Sunday Dec 3rd

I have had a very
lovely day today but
we did not get out
to church today as
Papa slept too late
and I think it was
just as well for
you were not very
showy as yet. Papa
gets in so late Saturday
nights that he gets
very tired. Then after
we had had our dinner
Uncle Frank came in
with your little ones
out in your cubby, and
Papa and I took a
walk with him which
did us all lots of good.

1905
Monday Dec 31-

We are all looking forward to a big time tomorrow as Grandpa and all the rest of the family are coming to spend the day with us tomorrow. We will have a big time that I know and we will do lot of things to please them too if we can - You took your little sled out and tried to slide down hill today for a little while and you had lots of fun by yourself -

Tuesday Jan 1 -

This has been a big day for you children and for Mama too -

They all came and I had a good visit until dinner time then after dinner in just - could do nothing but sit in health for we all too full - for any thing else - In the even-

Papa stayed with you little ones and Aunt Bessie and Mama took a ride until after nine o'clock and then we were nearly tired,

Wednesday Jan 2 -

Aunt-Bertha was
with us to Breakfast
this morning and we
first did drying it took
and then this morn
she came again
and then today Mama
did lot of washing
because we are going
over to spend the
day at Gundrun's
tomorrow. You are
looking forward to
it as much as Mama
for we have not
been there for many
times.

19th
Sunday June 3

Today was a very cold day indeed but we took our trip over to the farm just the same and had a lovely day there. You did not notice the cold nor going much but still - both it did make sick. You had a good time over there and was not ready to come home when we did. You must be bed early and sleep well you.

1906

Friday June 4

This has been another
very lovely day and
very little was done
than a big time.

You little friend
Blanche came this
afternoon and you
played with your
dollies until you
were tired then
stir every you
spent the time in the
parlor with Mama
You are very tired
and Mama will
now lay this aside
and put you into your
little bed -

Saturday Jan 8 -

You have had a good day today my little maid. This morning you spent part of the time at Margunja and this afternoon after you nap you had a big time again - You had a great time sliding down hill part of the time and then this evening you and brother had lots of fun together until your bed time. Maria is glad you are feeling so much better than you have.

1901

Sunday Jan. 6 -

This has been another
very lovely Sunday for my
little folks. You did not
get to church again my
little maid for you have
not been very well and
beside your Papa has had
to work so hard and late
that he has not felt like
getting up early this morning.

After our dinner and a
good visit with Papa you
and brother had a good and
long ride with Papa and
Mama. Papa was very
thoughtful and ordered a
very easy carriage.

This made it very lovely
for all. Then we came
home and went to bed early.

Monday ¹⁹⁰¹ Jan 7 -

It has been not-
altogether pleasant outside
for little ones and yet-
Papa came home early
this morn and took
you and brother down
the hill on your sled -

Then after your nap
you put on your maps
my little maid and
started out to play alone.

Papa soon came and
helped you with your
fun and took brother
out too. You all came
in very hungry and
wanted to know why
supper was not ready.
You could hardly wait

-1901-

Tues day January 8 -

It has been very disagreeable outside today and my little girl could not go outside. You and brother have been very contented inside however and have had lots of fun in our way and another. This morning you had company to help you out and this afternoon you have played all by your selves.

This evening you are very busy with your picture books and holly-burner?

Wednesday Jun 9

This has been a lovely day though a trifle cold. You were out some this afternoon. You took a walk up town with Maria and while up there I met Aunt Carrie with little Helen and you and she did have lots of fun. You went up the streets together as though you owned them and then you took your own pocket-book and bought five cents worth of peanuts. When you found you had to part with so many peanuts you did object and could not understand -

1901

Thursday Jan 10 -

It has been a lovely day above but very hard walking. You and sister had a good time this morning playing inside and this afternoon after you nap we all took a walk down town again.

Papa came home with us and we had a good brisk walk and felt much better after we came home. Then this evening we told a few stories and then went to bed early and felt much better and slept well all of us -

1906

Friday Jan 11

It has been a strongly
lovely winter day and
how much fun you
had playing out in
the snow. You took
your little sled this
morning and went
over to Blanchier
and coasted down her
little hill in her
yard and such fun
as you did have.

Then this afternoon
Aunt Bassie took us
all out for about an
hour and we did
have such lots of
fun. The sleighing was
good and it was fun,

1901 -

Saturday Jan 12 -

This was another very
big day for you my little
maid. You did have
lots of fun. Your little
friend Ethel came down
this afternoon or rather
this morning and played
all day with you, then
after your nap we took
you and hopped in
your sleds and gave
you a good old fashioned
sleigh ride. You rode
on your stomach
part of the time and
part of the time you
walked. It was fun.

Sunday Jan 13 -
1887

Another very lovely
day has gone by for
you my little girl.

You find Papa all day
and this did delight -
you more than I can
say. After our breakfast
we walked up town
all of us together and
took our dinner at
the hotel. Then we
took a slow walk
toward home. We stopped
at the home of one of our
friends and you and
brother did enjoy this
phonograph they had
there so much. So you
had a big time.

1901 -

Monday Jan 14 -

This forenoon you
and your little friend
Blanchie had a most
lovely time coasting
and pulling each other
around on a hand sled,
then after you nap
you were out again ^{and}
you did have a most
lovely time I can tell
you.

This evening you were
not very tired or sleepy
either from so you had
quite a time to get
to sleep and it gave
Mama a very short
evening for herself.

Tuesday Jan 13 -

It has not been the
most pleasant day
for you little ones
still you have been
out quite a little.

Little Helen was
down and spent the
day with us and
my son and I was
indeed a happy little
maid. You were
very good all day
and played very
nicely together only
did not get your nap
as you could not
make up your mind
to get to sleep together.

Wednesday Jan 16-

It has been very
unpleasant all of this
day for little me still
you were out quite a
little this morning -

This afternoon you did
not cry to go but Mama
could not let you as
it was too stormy -

You played with
your dolls for a long
time and then took
a good long nap -

This evening all is
quiet and you have
both gone fast asleep
early -

Thursday Jan 17

It has been very cold outside today and yet - my little Sonja was out with her sled this morning and had a good time coasting as long as you could endure the cold. Then after you nap little Blanchie came over and after you had a good romp then you little brother and Mama took a walk up to see Auntie Hatch and after that we took a good brisk walk in the open air you pulling and Russell riding and Mama driving.

Friday ¹⁹⁰¹ Jan 18 -

This has been a day
a little colder than
yesterday and yet you
did have such a good
time out. Papa came
home a little early
this noon, for he knew
Mama was feeling
very poorly, and took you
and brother out coasting.

You did enjoy it so much
Papa came in so cold
and you both ate such a
hearty dinner to make
up for the good time
you had.

Mama loves to see
you go out to play alone,
You are doing so nicely.

Saturday Jan 19th -

It has been so very cold, much colder than it has been for some time. You tried to go out today but you could not endure the cold so you came in and played very contentedly.

You are such a little independent-maid, You dress yourself from your bonnet to your moushoes without Mama helping in the least.

You do so much more than your little playmates at your age -

Sunday ^{19th} July 20 -

This has been a very
lovely day and after
our breakfast we dined
and walked down to
Sunday School. You
were very happy
there among all the
little ones of your own
age and then having
brother there with you
for his first time
did please you lots.
Then from there we
took our dinner at a
Hotel and then you
did enjoy going over
to Grandpa's with Uncle
Thaddeus and Aunt Brown.

- 1901 -

Monday Jan 21 -

This day has been very pleasant out and my little ones could do no more than stay in quite closely. You had a grand time however for Mama took you out in your cab for a time tonight; You felt very sorry to bid Uncle Harry and Aunt Bassie good bye for they started for N.Y. tonight to spend a week. Your little head did nearly break.

1901 -

Tuesday Jan 22 -

This has been a
red little day for us
as Uncle Harry said
on night over his
house while he was
away so Papa took me
out for an hour this
afternoon; out into the
country. You and
brother and Mamie
were very happy and
it did us much lots
and lots of good.

Then Papa came home
quite early and we
enjoyed that most
as much as the ride.

Wednesday Jan 23 -

Papa took us all
out moving over &
spent the day with
Grandma and Grandpa
and this was did
enjoy so much.

Grandma had to
be in bed all day and
you and brother were
a little comfort to her.
Then we came
home after supper
and went to bed
early and my
little ones were very
very tired. Papa was
hiking quite early.

-1901-

Thursday Jan 24 -

Well my little son
did not wake up feeling
very well this morning
and you have had
a very bad day of
it. Mama has done
all she could to make
her little ones comfortable
but you do not seem
much better this am.
than you did this
morning -

I think perhaps you
must have taken
cold yesterday, But
Mama hopes it will
all end well.

-1900-

Friday Jan 23-00

My dear little girl
did not feel any
better today than you
did yesterday and
Mama has worried
more than a little
about it. Mama
called the doctor this
afternoon. You have
a very high fever.

The doctor says you
have a high fever
and are a very sick
little girl. But Mama
will do all she can
for her little ones -

Friday May 24 -




