RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE BUSINESS MANAGER

1. That a contract for the concrete retaining wall along the southeast portion of Camp Randall be awarded to George Nelson of Madison, for the sum of \$2,000, and that the Business Manager be authorized tosign the contract. Chargeable to 20.41(5)C.

2. That an additional \$150 be made available for the Science Hall elevator project. Chargeable to Regents' Unassigned, Capital. Adopted.

RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE SECRETARY

1. That the gift of \$5,000 from Richard T. Ely, to establish the Anna Morris Ely Scholarship in Economics, in accordance with the terms of an agreement dated June 19, 1925, now on file in the Regents' office, be accepted, and that a check from Richard T. Ely for \$250, to provide for the scholarship for 1925-26, be accepted. Adopted.

 RESOLVED, That the gift made in provision fifth of the
 will of the late John M. Olin to The Regents of the University of
 Wisconsin, of \$10,000 to establish the "Harriet Remington Laird
 Fellowship Fund", be and the same is hereby accepted, subject to
 all the terms and conditions set forth in the will.

- 3. That in contemplation of the Wisconsin University Building Corporation acquiring title to Lots 16, 17, 18, Block 6, University Heights, from the John M. Olin Estate, and securing a loan for the amount of the purchase price, the Regents authorize the President and Secretary of the Board to sign a lease with said Building Corporation for said property at an annual rental of \$1,800, to provide for the payment of interest and reduction of principal, with the understanding that when the loan is fully paid the title to the property will pass to The Regents of the University of Wisconsin and that this purchase precludes the

erection of a garage at any time on the Olin homeste which was bequeathed to the Regents.
