Fri. Dec. 11—Brigham Young

Champions of Rocky Mt. conference; one of greatest scoring teams in the country; big men, speedy, all 5 on offense; all shoot and follow in for rebounds; test for Wisconsin defense; average nearly 50 pts. per game.

Tues. Dec. 15—Pittsburg

Annually best team in East last 5 years; fast; last trip west, defeated 4 out of 5 Western Conf. teams played; Hyatt was a former Pittsburg star.

Mon. Dec. 21—Marquette

Marquette defeated Wisconsin last year; score—Marquette 16, Wisconsin 14; coached by Bill Chandler, former Wisconsin star.

Wed. Dec. 30—Univ. of Maryland

Champions of Southern Conference of 19 teams; big and very tall and a high scoring team.

Sat. Jan. 9—Michigan

2nd place tie; entire team back including Daniels.

Mon. Jan. 18—Northwestern

Last year—conference champions.

Wed. Feb. 10—Butler

Mid-West Champions; two years ago National Champions; high scoring Indiana State team.

Sat. Feb. 27—Purdue

2nd place tie; entire team back including Wooden—All conference guard—2nd high scorer in Big Ten.

Sat. Mar. 5—Indiana

Lost but one man; annually a good team.

Mon. Mar. 7—Minnesota

2nd place tie; practically same team this year; Minnesota defeated Wisconsin in both games last season.
