

Thursday May 10 -

Today you have very happy children again. You have played so good together. Grandpa and Aunt Ida came down a little while this afternoon to see you and you were delighted. Uncle Herman had been here to dinner too which made you more than happy. You girls did enjoy yourselves all day I can tell you. Aunt Grace and the cousins took a nice ride with Aunt Barnum again today.

Friday May 11 -

Aunt Grace and
Baby cousin were at -
Aunt-Carrie today and
as usual you missed
them very much.

Cousin Helen came
down and spent the
afternoon with you as
Aunt-Carrie gave a
tea party for Aunt-
Grace and it made
it pleaseant for Helen
to be here and you
were most delighted
to have her. It kept
Mama busy to keep
watch of you two little
runaways -

Saturday May 12

Today has been very
warm and yet a very
lovely and pleasant
day all the trees are
in their fullest blossom
and how perfectly lovely
everything is.

Mama is simply in
love with the blossoming
lime. You are so very
fond of flowers too. You
seem to admire even
a little blossoming weed.

You have often come
to me with only the
nearest-blossoming weed.

Mama is happy over the
way you show for flowers.



Sunday May 13 -

This has been another
very lovely Sunday for
us all. Papa took us
all out for a long drive
after a good Sunday dinner
in our happy little
house. We drove to the
Welch farm. You saw
all the cows come home
from their meadow
pasture to the barn
for the night. You
were delighted. Then
we drove over to the
farm house to see our
Grandma who is sick
in bed. She was very
glad to see us indeed.
We wereriegled there
and gamma home happy.

Monday May 17

Today has been a
very pleasant day and
you both were very happy
with little cousin all
of the forenoon and Aunt
Grace took a ride with
Aunt Bassin this morning
and took dinner there
and supper at our house.

Mrs. Parson called
while Mamie was out
for a ride with Aunt
Currie. It did Mamie
lots of good too to get
out a little of the time.
You stayed at home
with Emma and I
took little brother with
me this evening

Tuesday May 18-

Today you were at home all day without your little Cousin for he was at Aunt-Carrie's all day. You had a good time though for so many of the little neighbors children came in and helped make the time pass very swiftly by.

Then Aunt-Bessie came and took Mama for a ride and you said you were glad Mama could go out. It seemed to please you very much.

Wednesday May 14

This has been a most-
beautiful day. It has
been warm and pleasant
to be out and it did you
lot's of good. This
afternoon you were at
Blanchard Galahar to
play and you did have
a big time and you did
not miss Aunt Grace and
little George & Emanuel
as much as Mamie
thought - you might, for
Aunt Carrie took them
out for a ride over to
the farm house very
early this afternoon and
they had a good time.

Thursday May 17 -

Today Aunt-Gene
took Elmer at-Aunt-
Bessie's and supper
too and it has rained
most of the day ^{and}
you little ones could
not go out any, but
Mama built a fire in
the grate and you
played about it as
good as two children
could possibly be.

You did not care to go
to bed tonight for you
heard that-Aunt-Gene
was going to see Uncle
Henry from New York.

Friday May 18 -

Uncle George came
last night - and had
a good time coming
he said and brought
some nice things and
Russell a stick pin.

He brought Mamma
a half dozen head and
butter knives. It pleased
Mamma more than I
can say. It has been
rather cold and rainy.
but you were glad to
have Uncle George here,
it pleased us all.

Tonight - Aunt Grace played
at the church and she did
very well and looked nice too.

Saturday May 19 -

Today has been a very beautiful day and everything outside has been beautiful all day. After dinner we took a drive over to the farm and then we drove home and had the little cousin with us on the ride too. You little ones canna know wey tried after you little play at the farm with the rest of the cousin over there. It always does Mama good to see yo

Sunday May 2^d -

It has been another
model day and after
the babies had their
baths Uncle George took
Aunt June and the
babies to town near by
and they had their
dinner there and the
carries home to take
thee with Aunt Bessie
for the last time before
they return to New-
York City. You were
both in your little
beds when they came
home.

This has been a very
busy day for us all
as Uncle George starts
for the City tonight.

It is your last day of
play for and with your
little cousin George
Emmanuel. They have
been at the fair and
other places most of the
time today and you
did not see very much
of him, but you love
him just the same.
You went to the train
and saw them leave
on this train.

Tuesday May 22 -

This morning early
and before my little
girl was up from
her little bed we
had all the carpets
up down stairs and
were all down w^t fr
house cleaning. You
did not know your
house and how little
brother did open his
eyes. He likes the
bare floors and seemed
to enjoy getting around
on them. We kept
ever all very busy
to keep track of duty.

Wednesday May 23 -

This forenoon little friend Blanchie came in to play with you again and it did Mama good to have it so far Mama had to go up town to pick out some carpets and had lots to do. Then Aunt Bassin asked us to come over there and take dinner with her which we did and then this afternoon you are at Blanchie after your nap.

Thursday May 24.

You simply know
her a poor neglected
little girl since this
house cleaning first
began. You know looked
as though your Papa and
Mamma had you all
back on you sure and
yet you are just as
happy as you can
be never the less.

There were several
of your little friends
on the lawn with
you this afternoon. Your
mix of laughter could
be heard above them all.

Friday May 25 -

Today you have
seen a sight - that
will please you to
say the very least -

You never had seen
any one nail a carpet
down before and how
went down today and
you simply could not
understand. Little
Grotes was afraid of
the man who did
the work and stood
and cried every time
he turned and saw
him.

Saturday May 26 -

Today you were at
cozy Basleidovs part
of the town and at
Blanchies too some
of the afternoon.

Mama called you
in very early and
gave you a lovely
bath and then put
you both to bed early.
This did you lots of
good and Mama was
very glad it had him
down for Mama is
tired and sleepy
to I can tell you.

Sunday May 27

This has been a long
useful day for us all
and it is what we
all need here very
much. It has been
raining all the morning
so we could not go
out to church and
so we stayed at home
and rested in the
morning and then this
afternoon And Benji
and Uncle Harry
took you over to
Grandpa's. You had a
most delightful ride and
then they came to lunch.

Monday May 28 -

This has been a
much pleasanter
day than yesterday
so you little ones
put on your rubber
and started out this
morning on the lawn
for a good time.

You both did him
a favor. You did all
you could to keep
little brother happy
until his lecture
and then you ran
and spent the rest
of the day at Hattin
Breed.

Tuesday May 29 -

This day has been
hard fit us in many
ways. We have kept
very busy and we
hardly knew what to
do first or last.

You did play here
all day and Mama
was glad of that
for Mama could not
spend much time visiting
after little over the
house cleaning time.

You had a good romp
this evening and sleep
on your bed.

Wednesday May 30

This has been a wonderful day for you. You could not easily understand what to make of decoration day. You went up to the cemetery this morning and placed a bunch of flowers on Grandmum's grave you self. Then a little later you sat in the hammock and watched the parade pass by and you were very much surprised.

Thursday May 31 -

This forenoon I am
and Russell played
very contentedly in
our yard. This after-
noon the man came for
your little brother to
take his nap you biggs
to play with Father
this Mama granted.

This afternoon little
Blanchie came and
you played very
peacefully together. Mama
was obliged to spank
you quite a little and
you asked me wherefore
I did not love you very much.

Friday June 1 -

This was not a very
pleasant forenoon for
my little Sonja for it
rained the most of the
morning and yet Blanchie
came over and asked for
your company until
dinner time and you
of course went. You
soon home however
about eleven o'clock
with a cut in your finger.
this was your first and
so Mama of course made
lots of trouble, but
you soon returned with
Blanchie quite happy.
After your nap this afternoon
you got ready for the band
concert this evening.

Saturday June 2 -

My little Bonita has had a good time today. She played with her little brother until it was time for him to nap then you ran over to see your little friend Hattie for a little while and then after your nap this afternoon you and your little friend Blanche took a walk up town with Mama.

You were delighted with a little hat. Mama gave you time to play in the yard with

Sunday June 3 -

This has been the
kind of a day that -
you are in town with
above all other days -

You had a good long
ride over to the farm
town after you had been
at church. Then you
spent a happy afternoon
with Helen and Mairi.

This evening you
enjoyed your ride home
and were very ready
for your bed and sleep
when you reached
it. Maria was very
tired too, for we found
Grandma feeling and
looking bad.

Monday June 4 -

Today has been a very busy day for Mama but you have been a very good little girl. This forenoon Uncle Herman came in and stayed to dinner with us and this afternoon you spent a little of your time with little Hanchie.

Then this evening Mama packed up some with you to meet Papa. Then it is overing us hurried into our little beds -

Tuesday June 5 -

This has been a perfect day for little Sora. So early this morning Aunt Camia let Helen and Morris come down and you had lots of fun all the morning then this afternoon you went out for a walk with Helen and Morris then you came in and after tea Mama took you and both up town to hear the band play on the street; You then came home a tired and sleepy little girl.

Wednesday June 6 -

Today my little girl could not go outside once. It has simply poured down all day.

You have been very happy inside however,

You have played and been very kind to your little brother in every way.

This afternoon little Helen and Morris have come down to play with you again and this has pleased Mama lots. You do always have such a good time together.

Thursday June 7-

My little girl has had a perfect day today Mama knows as she has spent the day at Grandpa's.

You drew nearly all the may over and the very first thing that you did was to tell Grandpa all about your new yard hot and asked him to admire it. You then began your days play and that was nearly all Mama saw of you until it was nearly time to return to your home. Tonight you took our hand full from the porch and it frightened Mama most terribly.

Friday June 8-

So you dear you have
been a happy little
one today again. You
were dressed and ready
for the day early this
morning and when
your little cousins
Helen and Morris came
down to play you were
more than ready.

Then this afternoon after
your nap they came
down again and you
spent as equally a happy
afternoon. Then this evening
Aunt Bessie and Uncle
Harry came over and
we went up town
together and spent a pleasant
evening.

Saturday June 9 -

You and little brother
have been busy little
folks all of this day
and you have had a
most lovely time too.

Uncle Herman came
down and worked the
yard for us and
stayed to dinner and
you did have such
a good time with
him that you were
most happy. Then this
afternoon after your
nap you went up
town with Mamie.

Tonight you look very
much as though you
were broken out with
measles.

Sunday June 10 -

This has been a very
restful day for my
little girl. We have not
been out of the house
except on our lovely lawn.

You are simply Scarlet
with measles. You
are not the least bit
sick but simply not
very good natured.

You seemed to
enjoy this day from
first until last. You
feared every minute
that Papa would leave
you and go to the
shop today. You could
not go to Sunday School
and that grieved you some.

Monday June 11 -

This morning you and brother spent playing very lonely together out in the yard. You are very good natured considering your being all broke out with some kind of rash. Then after your nap this afternoon Mamma took you and little brother down town and bought you a new doll head.

This made you more than happy. You just had a lonely time this afternoon for your feet you had a whole new dollie.

Tuesday June 12 -

Little sister had a another lovely day. You and little brother played outside very lonely all of this morning and this afternoon you took a ride in your car then after supper you went playing out in the yard when Aunt Bertha and Uncle Harry drove by and took you out for a ride all the evening. You did have a finer time too.

Your little brother looked as longingly after you when you started away,

Wednesday June 13 -

You have made this another very busy day for yourself my little maid. You were invited by Aunt Carrie and Aunt Bessie to come and spend the day with them but you did not care to so you were here to start for Grandpa's early this morning. You did have a good time here today for every thing was turned up for house cleaning. You helped sew rips in the carpets and every thing you could. You made Grandpa smile lots of times too.

Thursday June 14 -

You my little girl
have had a big time.
You and little brother
started over to Aunt-Bessie's
early this morning to make
a call. You stayed there
some little time then
you came home all
tired out.

Then after you naps
you played about the
yard and took a drive
with Emma in your
car. This evening
Aunt-Bessie and Uncle
Harry and Bessie's mother
and another friend came
to dinner since you can't ^{easily}

Friday June 15

Today my little girl
and my Aunt - over to
Grandpa's to spend the
day and Maime helped
about the house cleaning.

You did enjoy the
great mix up of things
there and so did your
Mother. Then you both
enjoyed the lovely ride
home in Grandpa's
double buggy. You came
home very tired and
sleepy and so did
Maime so we just
crept into our bed early.

Saturday June 16-

This has been another
very pleasant day
for you my little one.
You helped Mama
about the unpacking
up stairs today and
then after your nap
you took a walk up
town with Mama.

Mama gave many
little things to make
you very happy. You
had a treat to Lee
Orange Soda by your
second cousin Fred Carter
Jr. You were quite happy
with it too.

Sunday June 17 -

My little Sona girl
spent a very lonely
Sunday. You woke up
very early and very
happy too. Then after
a pleasant morning with
Mamma you went to the
Bailey House with
Uncle Harry and Aunt
Bessie and Mamma and
Papa then from there
you took a long ride
with Aunt Bessie and
Uncle Harry. Then you
came home about
seven o'clock a very
tired and sleepy little girl.

Monday June 18 -

My little Sonja was
a dear little thing all
the morning and off to
dinner little did Mamie
think that she was
dressing her little one
to be separated from her
from two dogs and one
night. Grandma was
latter very sick last
night and so Mamie
had to go there today
and finding her so
bad could not go back
home today and so I
stayed until tomorrow.
You spent the day and
night with Aunt Sophie.

Tuesday June 19 -

This forenoon my little girl went at Aunt Sophie's and Mamie at Grandmama's but after dinner about four o'clock Mamie called at Aunt Sophie's for you and you were so much delighted that you fairly fell over me trying to kiss Mamie.

You tell Mamie you will always be a good little girl after this and never make her feel bad if I only never will go away where and leave you & know again,

Wednesday June 20-

This has been another
very lovely day for
you little folks and
Mama has enjoyed
seeing you play about;
you have been very
satisfied to play with
brother since he came
back. After dinner
today you were very
much surprised to find
Uncle Frank here to see
you. You threw your
arms around his neck
and gave him a very
hearty welcome. It did
Mama good to see you.

Thursday June 21 -

Today my little
Sonia girl had a call
from little Blancher.
She came to ask Mama
to let you come over
here to play. Mama
did let you go this
morning and you both
had a good time. Then
this afternoon And-
Bassie came over to sit
with Mama for a
short time and you
had as good a time as
the rest of us. Mama
loves to have you play
outside these days.

Friday June 22 -

This has been a very disagreeable day. It has rained the most of the day. You could not go out - away until after your nap this afternoon.

Then while you were outside two or three of your little friends came in to play with you.

You had a good time after all and it left Mamma feeling quite comfortable. Little brother and you both have been very good all of this day.

Saturday June 23 -

This forenoon you and little brother had a good time playing together then this afternoon you went down town with Mama and we bought a few things that pleased you very much. Then we stopped into Halmar for a few moments but did not see her as she was asleep. Then Mama gave you a glass of ice cream Soda as she does every Saturday afternoon. You were much delighted with it.

Sunday June 24 -

Grandpa came down
this morning and brought
Aunt Ida to stay with
Mama while he went
to church. This was
just what did suit you
my little maid. Then
he took you brother
and Mama over and
Papa came on his
wheel. We had a good
time and it pleased
Grandma so much to
see us. Then we came
home and you took a
ride with Mel Clegg
and came home tired.

Monday June 25--

Today my little girl had a day at home without her Mother for I was having a day's outing with Papa at Grand Rapids. We had a good time and you were very happy too as Emma Johnson came and stayed with you while Mama was gone.

Papa bought my little girl a good horse let and you were more than delighted too. It did Mama good to see you all.

Tuesday June 26 -

Maria was very
busy this morning and
you and little brother
were by yourselves
most of the time and
played very nicely too.

Then this afternoon
we sat outside of five
o'clock and moved about
very slowly as it has
been so very warm.
About the very unusual
day after dinner I think
Aunt Bassin came
over a milk this
afternoon and gave us
a little surprise.

Wednesday June 27 -

To day Papa has gone
to Grand Rapids and
this leaves us alone
to have each other.

Two of your little
friends came over to
play with you most of
the day. You had a
good time around the
humpock and with
your balls. You have
been good all day.

You have walked
bare footed all day and
have been very happy
because you come.

Thursday January 28

Well my little Sonja
girl is tired tonight;
you have had a big
day playing. This
afternoon you played
about in your bare feet
and this afternoon you
could not bear it - was
too cool. You spent a
little of this day at
Hutties playing croquet.
You seemed to enjoy
that so much. It
did Mama lots of
good to see you. You
try so hard to help
Mama about - keeping
Russell at home, but he won't
mind us.

Friday June 29.

This has been another much warmer day than it was yesterday. You and little brother have been at home most of the time and Mama has enjoyed having you too. Then this evening Papa came home early which was a treat for you and Mama too.

Even little brother seemed happy to have him and would insist on getting up to welcome him home.

Saturday June 30 -

This forenoon you played about with brother and also over to Maryetta a little while. Then this afternoon you went down town with Mama to do her shopping, and also to get your usual drink of Ice Cream Soda. Then this evening we played about and sat about in the yard until the hour for your bath and preparation for bed, which Mama always finds so pleasant.

Sunday July 1 -

Early this morning
Papa called us to prepare
for a long drive out in
the country. You opened
your eyes happy and
ready and we had
a lovely time too.

We took about a sixteen
mile drive and reached
our destination about
half past eleven, ready
and hungry for dinner.
Then after a pleasant
afternoon with Uncle
and Aunt Schuler we
came home tired and
glad to get to rest for
the night.

Monday July 2 -

Again this morning
my little girl was
called early to open her
eyes to get ready for a
trip to Flint with Mama
to see Aunt Bertha. When
we reached the depot we
found we could not go
till tomorrow, so you
were obliged to come
home again and this
nearly broke your little
heart. You could scarcely
make up your mind
to wait though you
finally did, as you do
nearly every thing that
Mama insists on.

Tues day July 3 -

This has been the
third morning that my
little Anna has been
roused out of a sound
sleep to start out early
on a trip. This time
we did go and spent the
day with Aunt Bertha.

We think it did please
her very much and we
hope it did her lots of
good too. She seemed
very much pleased to
see you my little maid
and Mariae would
take nothing for the
good she hopes you did
for Aunt Bertha.

Wednesday July 4 -

This day you have enjoyed so much, for you were at Grandpa's all day and you were happy all day. You simply skipped around in your bare feet from morning until bed time. In the evening you enjoyed the fire works that Uncle Herman had more than any one else Mama thinks. You were sick last year and so this has been your first experience of which you remember.

Thursday July 5--

We did not go home last night as we expected to when we went to Grandmas but stayed all day today.

You did a thing today that you have never done before and that was to go berry picking in the woods with Mamie and Aunt Ida.

You became very tired before reaching home and sat in the verandah to rest and then in going down you sat on the big rocks and this made you tired too.

Friday July 4 -

We did not even go home last night - but stayed again. Papa helped Grandpa in the hay field and you and Mama helped and visited with Grandma.

But this morning we started for home.

Grandpa drove us home. You and little brother seemed glad to get into your own house again and see your own play things again.

And yet you had a good time visiting and seeing Grandmas.

Saturday July 7 -

Today you and
little brother were very
busy with your play
and this afternoon you
were at Maryanna's a
little later and Emma
took you for a ride
in your cub too.

Then this evening
Mama put you into
your little beds early
and you fell asleep
easily and sweetly
and this gave Mama
a little time to read
and think.

Sunday July 8 -

We have spent a
very lovely quiet-day
together. We were not
out as the weather
has not been as pleasant
as it might have been
for little ones, but our
day was complete for
we were all together.

Papa has been very
tired but has been
with us to lunch and
dinner. We are thinking
of retiring early so as
to feel rested and
ready for the next
morning.

Monday July 9-

My little Sonja has
enjoyed meeting a
new friend this day.

Uncle Frank's son's
sister. You look to her
and she to you from
the very beginning. Mama
loves to see you meet
her friends so heartily.

Then this afternoon
little Cosy Bartolo
came up this way to
spend the afternoon.
and you were together
the most of the time.
Little Blanchie came
over and took tea with
you tonight.

Tuesday July 10 -

Mama has been very busy today and my little girl has tried to help her by being a good little girl too. This afternoon you went over to Blanche's but not finding her at home you returned and asked Mama to spend a little time at Marguerie and this Mama granted. Then after tea you, Russell and I went over to Uncle Harry's and sat there for a little time. We had a very pleasant evening and then came home.

Wednesday July 11 -

This has been a most lonely day, neither too warm nor too cold for my little ones.

This morning you had four little friends come in to spend the morning with you and then after your refreshing nap this afternoon you spent some time with Margery Haigle. Then when you came home you found your dear little cousin Helen playing on the porch. You sat with her in the hammock. I will had a visitin,

Thursday July 12 -

This has been a great day for you. You have had a great time for it has been Aunt Bessie's and Uncle Harry's wedding Anniversary and we all went down to the fair ground grown in the bus.

You and Helen had a good time together. You were together all the morning too as Helen came down to spend the afternoon with you and you all played in the sand so nicely together and were just as good as you could be. Then after a nice refreshing bath you went to your little bed.

Friday July 13 -

My little sona girl
has had a lovely day
again for Blanchie came
over to spend the forenoon
with you. You and she
had the most fun with
your little dolls I think
this morning and then
after your nap you had
little Helen and Maria
to play with. Mamma
loves to sit in the
yard and see you little
ones play. It amuses
me more than anything
I can do and
often wish I had more
time to sit and watch

Saturday July 14 -

This is a lonely Saturday morning, and Mama does not feel very well. Do you told Mama in your lonely baby way that you would do the dishes and the work today and I might sit down to rest. It really did rest. Mama to see the earnestness in your expression. It has been very warm too and so my little folks have had to keep rather quiet for them but this afternoon that you went up town for your glass of ice cream soda with Emma, you came home as happy as a bird.

Sunday July 13 -

This has simply been a terribly hot-day and yet you have been very comfortable by staying in very closely and wearing very little. You and brother have looked sweet with your low neck and short-sleeves and bare feet.

We all took a nice cool bath this evening and then went to bed tired and ready for sleep. You have been so happy with you up all day to yourself and Mame and I.

Monday July 18 -

This forenoon my little girl could not go outside any for it had been raining and dump but still after you went over to Blanchard's and had a big time. Mama took you for a walk this morning and you have been quite happy since and I think will yet be your little red happy and at the same time very tired. Mama used to see her little girls have a good time

Tuesday July 17

This forenoon you had
a big time playing
with Blanchard and
your little brother
and often after
you nap this noon
you took a ride
in your cab and
Emma took you. Then
after supper we went
up town to do a little
shopping and also
to make some with
Pop a visit was a
great pleasure not
only to you but to each
one of us. You and
Brother were very tired

Wednesday July 14 -
Mama think it is
has been another
moder day. neither
too hot nor too cold.
You were out all the
forenoon and all the
afternoon too.

Then after dinner
we went up street to
do a little shopping
and also to see
our Papa. Mama had
her eyes everywhere
and we got along
very nicely. You and
Mother were both
very good too.

Thursday July 19 -

Well soon if any
one does have a good
time it is you, all the
day from morning until
night you are happy.

Your Mama has not
been well for some little
time, still I am feeling
some better. Your little
cousins Helen and Marie
came down today to
see you and you did
have a good time and
then Grandpa was
down for a few minutes
too. You have enjoyed it
all very much too.

Tuesday July 20 -

Today you did have
a big time again -

Uncle Harry was in
to supper and dinner
and you enjoyed that
very much and then
you had such a good
time with your friends.

Then today Mama
surprised you with a
nice new dollie.

You did love it so
much and have not
let it go out of your
arms not for a minute
all of this day. It did
Mama so much good to
see you so happy with it.

Saturday July 21-

two Emma's while
I went out to make
a call. You were
very good so the
report comes to me
Maria is glad.
She can leave you.

Saturday July 28 -

You did play very
lively with some
of your little friends
in the yard this
morning. You do have
some very good times
playing in the sand
box you have right-
by the side door.

Then this afternoon
Emma took you out
for a ride, and today
she slipped with you
while Mammie went
to a play. Coming she
had not down for
some time before.

Sunday July 29 -

It has been rather warm today and my little girl felt it quite a little after her walk down to the Bailey house for her dinner and back. Then after dinner we sat in the yard comfortably reading when Uncle Dugnack came and sat with us. We had a good time together. You seemed very happy to have her here.

telephoned for you to
come down there and
play in the sand with
Dorothy Soherer. Then
Helen came down to
spend the day so you
all went down together

until now. Then
this afternoon you and
Helen had a tea party
on the lawn and were
very happy.

we were in town. We were

see Grandmother with
us for she has not
been with us for so
long a time before.

town to meet Papa.

Thursday Aug. 2

Mamma has been
very busy today for
the house has become
very dusty because of
the dry time. And
you were very dear
to help Mamma as
much as you did.
Then it looked very

over to Blanchard playing
and Mamma always
tells her little Sonja

Tues day Aug 7 -

You were so warm today my little dear that it made you anything but goodnatured, Mamma was a little nervous too and it had its effect on you little ones too, little brother frightened Mamma too far he ran a needle into his foot today and yet it did no particular harm for which Mamma is very thankful.

You are so dear to us all and so is your sweet little brother,

Wednesday Aug 8 -

Aunt Currin came down this afternoon to visit with Mama for a few minutes and she brought the two children with her.

You did enjoy it so much. Tomorrow Aunt Currin and Grandpa are going to bring Aunt Bertha home to us. They will come home quite late tomorrow night.

You little son was Mama's little helper and comfut-all of this day, I think. Mama loves you more all the time.

Thursday Aug 9-

My little Son
promised her Papa this
morning that she would
not ask Mama to go
to spend the day an
part of it with any of
her little friends. It
has not been easy
for you at all times
to keep it but Mama
would ask you ask
your once in a while
about you had promised
and that would
always bring you
to keep it. You and
Russell and Mama
sat in the hammock a
long time this evening
try day to get cooled.

Friday Aug 10-

It has been exceptionally
warm and Mamie
has had you on her
mind almost all the
time trying to keep
you cool. You have
been very good all of
this day and this
afternoon Aunt Bassie
came over for a little
while. You enjoyed her
little stay very much.
Then your little friends
were in more or less
too all day. You do
have such good times
with the neighbor
children. It does me
good to see you.

Saturday Aug 11 -

It has been an exceptionally
warm day and Marcell
has kept her little deer
ones inside all of the
morning. You have had
almost nothing on trying
to keep cool. Helen
came down this
afternoon with Aunt-
Ida and you had a
good romp too.

Then after your nap
this evening you went
to playing all the
afternoon. We did enjoy
the lovely warm light-
cotton so gently after
such a hot spell as
we have had.

Sunday Aug 12th

This has been a very rainy day but Papa took us down to the hotel to dinner right in the rain to save Mama getting dinner. We had our fun out-of-it-all.

Then this afternoon we called on Auntie and Uncle Hatch. We did them lots of good and they did us good too.

You fell fast-asleep on Auntie Hatchers couch and took a good long nap. We spent a happy evening together then we all went to bed early.

Monday Aug 13 -

It looked like rain this morning Ed & Mama feared her little ones could not get out any today but I found that you could. You have had lots of fun today and Mama has enjoyed you very much. Aunt Ida came down to spend the day and Aunt Bertha came to spend the whole afternoon with us and then this evening we all went over to Aunt Bersier to tea. You enjoyed that very much had lots of fun.
