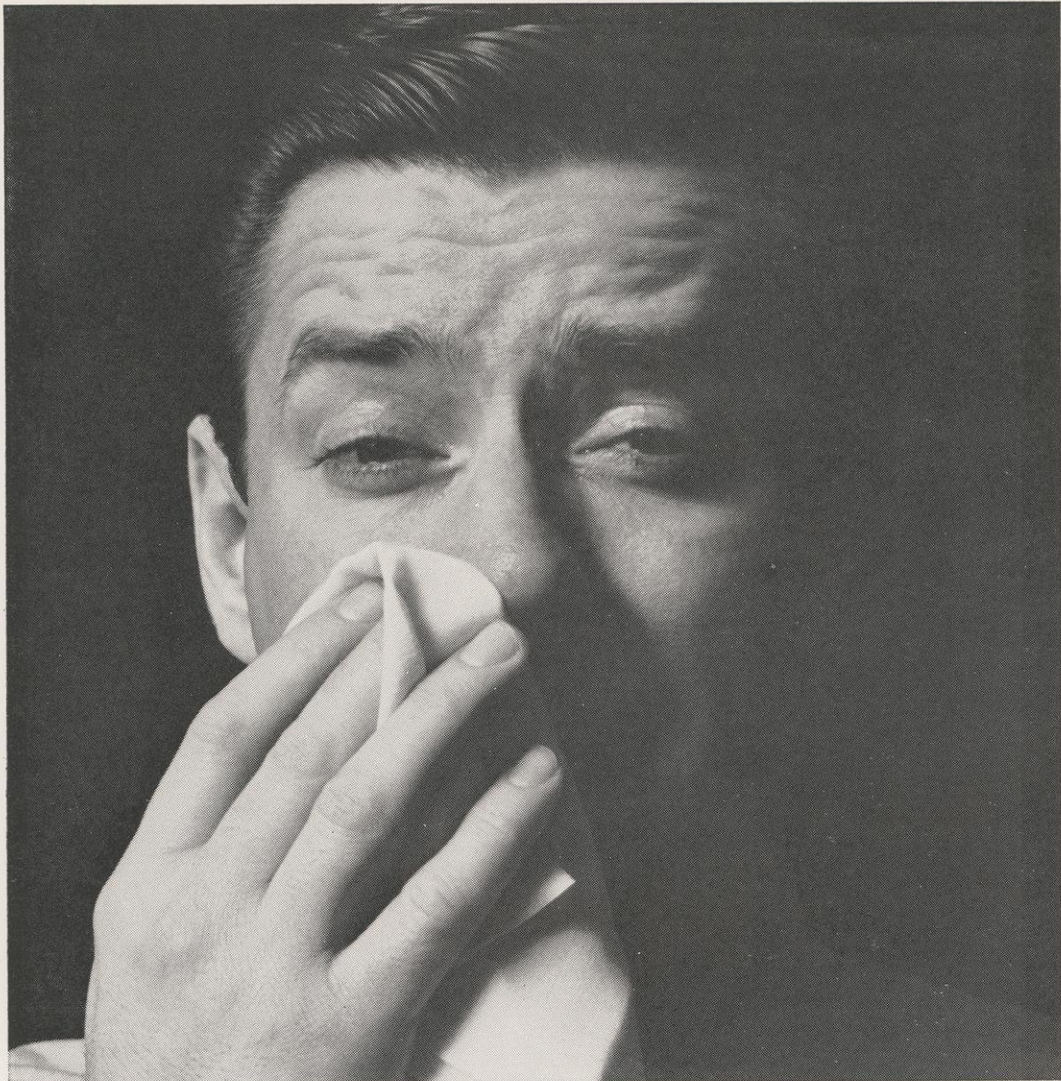

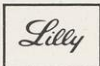

Co-Pyronil should be used with caution in the presence of hypertension, cardiovascular-renal disease, and hyperthyroidism. As with any preparation containing antihistamines and sympathomimetics, overdosage may produce excessive central-nervous-system depression or stimulation.
