HISTORY:

Originally named PERE MARQUETTE 17, she had a capacity for 30 freight cars and passengers. She was sold to the State of Michigan in November of 1940, reconditioned at River Rouge for use as a vehicle and passenger ferry at the Straits of Mackinac, and put in service there in the summer of 1941 renamed the CITY OF PETOSKEY.

In 1959 she was sold to K & K Truck Service Co. and used as a trailer ferry. She was sold for scrapping in 1961.
