# SECRETARY'S REPORT

February 1, 1936, to February 1, 1937

In the past year the efforts of your association as outlined by your Board of Directors, has been to encourage in every way possible the breeding of more useful cattle, the promoting of record keeping work among Vocational Agriculture Departments, the organization of Bull Associations and the conducting of Production Shows.

## Annual Meeting

The annual meeting was held at Oshkosh, Wisconsin, March 23 and 24. The program was designed to as completely as possible meet problems facing the dairymen in the state of Wisconsin. Nationally known speakers included John D. Jones, Jr., St. Paul, Minn., Karl B. Musser, Petersburg, N. H., D. M. Seath, Manhattan, Kansas, James W. Lacey, Madison, Wis., Dr. J. F. Kendrick, Washington D. C., Dr. O. S. Aamodt and Dr. Walter Wisnicky, Madison, Wis., and Lynn Edminster, Washington D. C. For the second consecutive year Governor Philip F. LaFollette proclaimed March 23 a state-wide dairy day and honored us with his presence as guest speaker at the annual Dairy Feast. More than a ton of Wisconsin milk was manufactured into the dairy products served at the banquet. Cooperating with the State Department of Agriculture and Markets a splendid window display campaign among the stores of Oshkosh did much to stimulate the consumption of dairy products in and about our convention city.

## Year Book

In connection with the annual meeting the second annual publication of the Wisconsin Dairymen's Association Year Book was distributed. Listed in this publication were the members of our association following a testing program, together with the number of cattle, their breed and whether these cattle were grade or registered.

## Awards

Award of merit plaques for distinguished service to the Wisconsin Dairymen's Association were awarded to Bennett Bird, Fond du Lac County, John Dobberstein, Outagamie county. Fred Burhop, Ozaukee county, Robert Moore, Barron county, and G. W. Lycan, Sheboygan county. A trip east was given to the outstanding cow tester, Arthur Hunsader for listing Ton Butterfat Cows. Trip awards were also made to Quentin Metzger, Fremont and Lyle Viney, Evansville in cooperation with Mount Hope Farm, Williamstown, Mass. Two other outstanding cow testers, Obert Morehouse, Waukesha and Ben Rehrauer, Milwaukee were awarded trips to the National Dairy Show, at Columbus, Ohio.

## Production Shows

Production Shows were held for the second consecutive year in the following counties: Dane, Sheboygan, Winnebago, Waukesha, Jackson, Manitowoc, Columbia, Kenosha, Dodge and Ozaukee. A total of 459 cows were shown at the ten shows. The outstanding event of the year was the All-State Production Show held at Barron. A total of 419 head were shown. More than 8,000 people attended. A great deal of credit for the success of this event must be given to business men, farmers and County Agent, I. O. Hembre, of Barron county.

## Supplies

More than 51,000 supplies were printed for the carrying forward of Junior D. H. I. A. testing work among Voca-

tional Agriculture Departments. Permanent Herd Book Covers have been supplied at cost to our Cow Testing members in the state. They were given to members of the Association.

### **Bull Associations**

Definite progress has been made in setting up a well organized program for keeping sires alive until they are proved. Associations have been organized in Outagamie, Monroe, Ozaukee, Winnebago, Columbia, Dunn, Jefferson, Waushara, Waupaca, Dodge and Trempealeau counties.

### **Artificial Insemination**

A few demonstrations on the matter of artificial breeding dairy herds have been conducted through your association's efforts. This year's convention program includes a speaker on this subject, in order to keep our membership informed on this work pioneered by your association.

### **Exhibits**

An exhibit panel portraying the various activities of the Dairymen's Association was shown at 13 Wisconsin fairs.

The outstanding exhibit of the year was made in cooperation with the Wisconsin State Fair, College of Agriculture, various breed associations, D. H. I. A. Fieldman and the James Manufacturing Company. Twenty-Five great breeding cows were placed on an elevated platform at the Wisconsin State Fair. There, through their combined recorded production of 2,579,684 lbs. milk and 98,694 lbs. fat, these cows demonstrated the importance of the brood cow and a continuous year-in and year-out testing program.

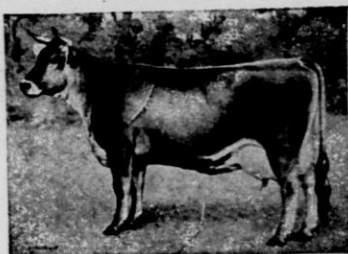

  - a. Is there a "success story" in your community?
6. Fairs and Expositions.
  - a. Can we assist you in your efforts to exhibit your cattle?
7. Rehabilitation of pure bred herds now "unregistered".
  - a. Let us send a field man to assist in making up applications for delinquent registrations.
8. Mixing breeds within a herd.
  - a. Let us tell you how you can meet any reasonable market demand by "farm standardization".
9. Holstein Boys' and Girls' Clubs.

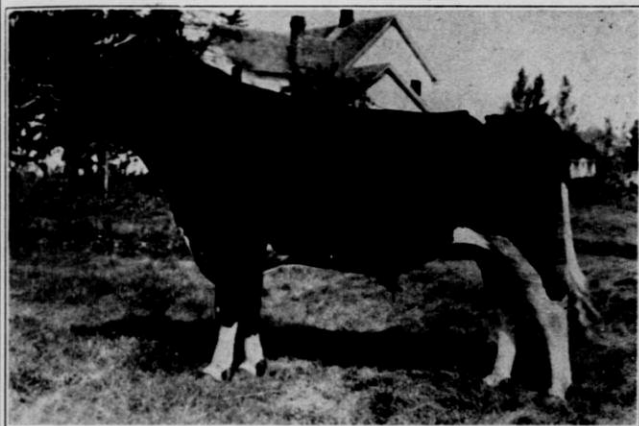

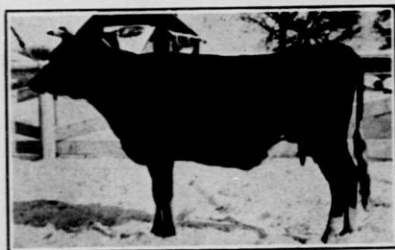
