## DESCRIPTION OF TOWNS.

**Barrow**—N. W. N. E. and center prairie and marsh, with small groves. E. and S. hills and openings. Past to Sec. 5 25, 29.

**Leavenworth**—North part hills and openings. Sec. 5 14, 15, 20 and 23 Round Prairie; 18, 21, 26, 29, 30, 31, 32 and 33 Round Prairie. In the north and quarter of sec. 5 there is a remarkable spring at the point where about 40 feet deep and from 50 to 60 in diameter.

**Lawrence**—S. E. and center openings. Southern 17, 18, 19, 20, 29, 30, 31, 32 and 33 Rock Prairie; S. E. openings, Sec. 3 12, 14, 22, 23, 24 and 25 marsh.

**Sec. 1, Chase**—South half openings; Lake marsh; N. E. openings. Sec. 5 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, and north half of 12, 17, and 18 Sugar Creek Prairie.

**Dodge**—Sec. 5 6, 7 and 8 Rock Prairie; East 12 Ridge Prairie; part of 10, 11, 14 and 15 Blaming Prairie; 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 22, 24, 25, 26 and 28 openings; remainder Prairie Prairie.

**Delaware**—Sec. 5 1, 4, 5, 6, 7, 15, 16, 17 and 18 Delaware Prairie. The remainder openings. Marsh adjacent to stream.

**Wagon**—Openings, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 and 18. Past to Sec. 5 5 and 12.

**Waterbury**—North part rolling openings; S. part openings; south of sec. 5 7, 8, 10 and 11 Big Foot Prairie.

**Two**—Marsh bordering on Heavy Creek and parts of S. E. 3, 10 and 12; remainder prairie and openings.

**East Two**—Rolling hills. Marsh openings, with some marsh bordering on Heavy Creek and the lake.

**LaFayette**—S. E. Spring Prairie; N. E. and S. W. openings. Marsh along Sugar Creek and Tributaries. Spring Prairie. Rolling Prairie and openings, with few groves.

**Green**—Northern part prairie. Central hills. Southern woodland.

**Heavy**—South of Burlington and Green. East hills and marsh; Northern and Western part openings.

**Lake**—Northern part, bordering on Lake George; woodland; Central openings and S. E. Prairie.

**Homestead**—Southern and Western parts. Prairie; S. E., rolling timber land.
