SUBJECT: Issue of Equipment and Foodstuffs to the teacher volunteer teams.

Reference is made to the Education Service's letter No. 150 dated 6/8/1971 to Colonel Sichanh Thommavongs, Chairman of the Joint Committee for the Protection of Luang Prabang, to the effect that 3 teacher volunteer teams are going to set out to perform work during the summer vacation of this year to help the refugees and others, and that the Ministry is requested to consider the possibility of issuing equipment and foodstuffs to these teams for offical use and consumption during their work performance. The Ministry and USAID have joinly considered this matter and agreed to issue the following:-

500	Shovels	50	ea.
	Hammers	30	ea.
400	Ripsaws	20	ea.
440	Handsaws	20	ea.

All these items have already been delivered to Col. Sichanh Thommavongs in Vientiane.

You are requested to deliver the following items to Col. Sichanh
Themmawongs for further issue to these teams:-

-	Hoes	40	ea.
-	Machetes	90	ea.
•••	Milled rice 8	20	bags.
***	Salad oil	3	baxes.

At the same time, you are requested to advise these teams to help the refugees who have just returned to their home recently because the major part of their public facilities have been burnt down.

Please report to me of the action taken in this regard.
