
THE VERY BEST CHILD'S BED MANUFACTURED.

Handsome, Corrugated Brass Balls, which cannot be dented are now used on these beds.


THE INFANTS' COMFORT CRIB.




The folding of the crib is very simple and when folded still rests upon casters so that it may be rolled under an ordinary bedstead without removing the bedding from the crib. 
THE INFANTS' COMFORT CRIB.

The above illustration represents our Infants' Comfort Crib, with *new adjustable folding*' side. Nicely finished in imitation mahogany and walnut, also natural wood (hard maple).


WITH FOLDING SIDE. - FOLDED.

The folding of this side is very simple, there being no hooks or spring catches to unfasten. All that is required in folding is to slightly raise the adjustable side, which allows it to fold upon the inside of the cot, so that it may be rolled under an ordinary bedstead without removing the bedding from the crib. They are substantially made, the castings being made of malleable iron, and where an extra high side is wanted, makes the neatest, best and most practical side in the market. This side is so constructed that it may be easily attached to any of our cribs. Manufactured in the following sizes:

This crib combines strength, durability and lightness, besides being a most convenient and practical crib. It is made of all turned work, and has not the big, clumsy, awkward appearance so noticeable in other makes.



The Street of the state

The folding of this crib is by far the most simple used-any child can prepare it for use. These cribs, being the most compact packers in the market, recommend themselves to buyers, as freight and storage room are always points to be considered.

The device for holding the leg rigid is used by us only.



This illustrates our Nos. 10 and 11 crib with one side folded out, making it very convenient for the mother at night, as by thus using the crib alongside the bed, she can take care of her child without having to lift over the high side of the crib. This feature alone recommends our "Favorite" cribs in preference to any crib made. We wish to call your attention to the catch used on these crib sides—they are so arranged as to make the body rigid and tight, and not shaky and rickety like many others. Made of hard maple. Finished in natural maple, imitation mahogany, cherry and walnut.



Nos. 15 and 16.

The folding of this crib is so easy and simple that it does not require a big strong person to handle it, but can be prepared for use or folded by a child.



ONE SIDE FOLDED OUT.

This cut shows our Nos. 15 and 16 crib with one side folded out for the mother's convenience at night, thus using, she can take care of her child without having to lift over the high side. *All our cribs are on casters, both when raised and when folded.* We guarantee these cribs to suit. They are built in proportion and with taste every way. Made of hard maple. Finished natural finish, imitation mahogany and walnut.

PATENTED APRIL 14, 1885.

The basket being hung on four suspending rods renders it impossible to tip or cant sideways while the child is lying or standing at the side. It has a glide motion instead of a rock or swing —the basket always remaining level while in motion. They are mounted on wheels so they can be easily moved from place to place by a child. Furnished with a fine woven steel wire bottom. Finely finished in mahogany, walnut and maple.
