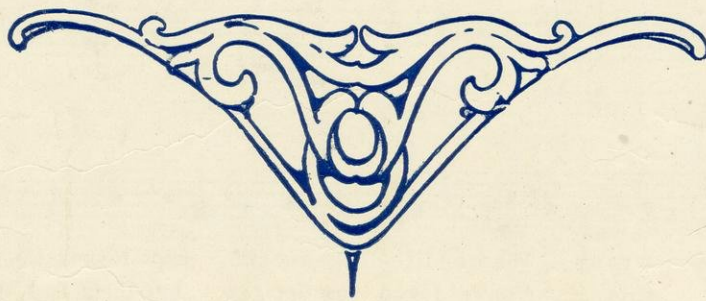

Intro.

The piano introduction is in 2/4 time, marked with a forte (f) dynamic. It features a melody in the right hand and a bass line in the left hand, both in B-flat major. The melody consists of eighth and quarter notes, while the bass line is primarily quarter notes.

Voice
