Update on Biennial Budget Requests, *p. 2*

President Schilling reported that the Governor and his staff had devoted considerable time to meeting with Vice President Lyon and him, as well as with President Shaw and his staff. Regents Schilling and Lyon also had been meeting with legislators and had spoken that morning with Speaker Loftus. While it was too early in the process for a status report, President Schilling indicated that there was much receptivity to regent views on the budget. He expressed appreciation to Vice President Lyon for the many times he had come to Madison for meetings in the past month and to President Shaw for his efforts in promoting the board's budget request.

REPORT OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE SYSTEM

Comments on Budget Requests

President Shaw thanked Regent President Schilling and Vice President Lyon for their work with the Governor and key legislators on the budget requests. He also was very appreciative that the Governor and Secretary Klauser had been willing to spend so much time understanding the UW System's needs.

Library Memorial

Status of the UW-Madison Memorial Library Building Project, *p. 2*

In response to a question by Regent Gundersen, President Shaw indicated that an agreement had been reached between the various parties that the UW-Madison Memorial Library addition would be lowered to preserve some view of the State Capitol. The space needs of UW-Madison would be met in another way, and there would be no additional cost to the project.


