

The culture of Wisconsin is showing improvement with the expansion of rural art. Shows such as we have here at the Wisconsin Union and the Regional Exhibits provide the incentive to rural people for such expansion. In the past 14 years this Rural Art Exhibit has grown from 68 pictures in 1940 to 144 pictures this year which were selected from 1734 entered in the 12 Regional Shows.

This year's show is being held from May 23 to July 13. Two sections will be set up, those artists over 18 in the first section, from May 23 to June 22, and those 18 and under in the second section, from June 24 to July 13. With this second section there will be a group of drawings selected from Let's Draw, the creative art program of the Wisconsin School of the Air. This is currently broadcast to 94,000 youngsters in Wisconsin's schools.

To be eligible, exhibitors in Rural Art Shows must be living on farms, in rural communities, or have farm backgrounds. All entries must be original works of art which have never been exhibited before in a State Show.
