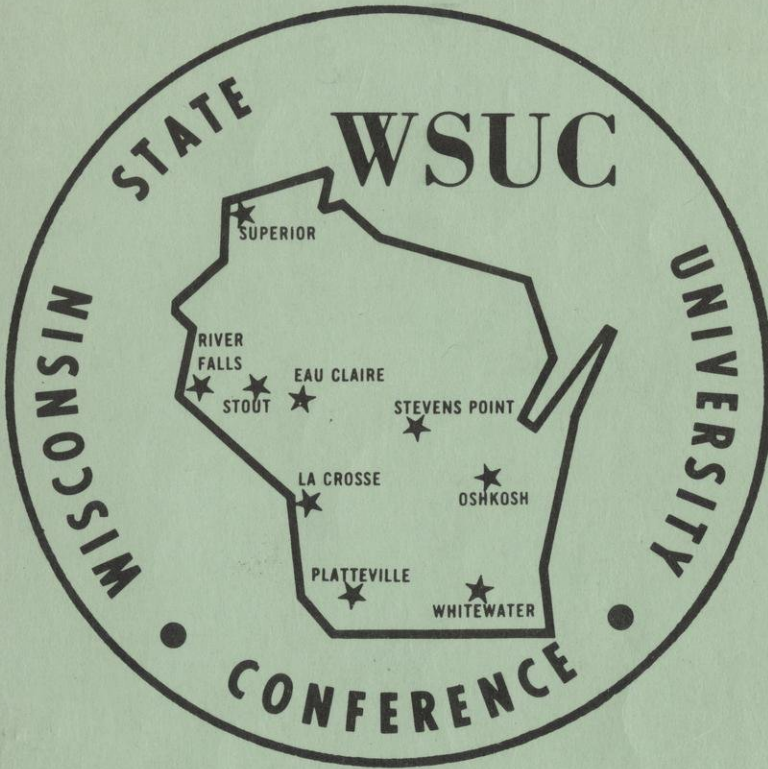

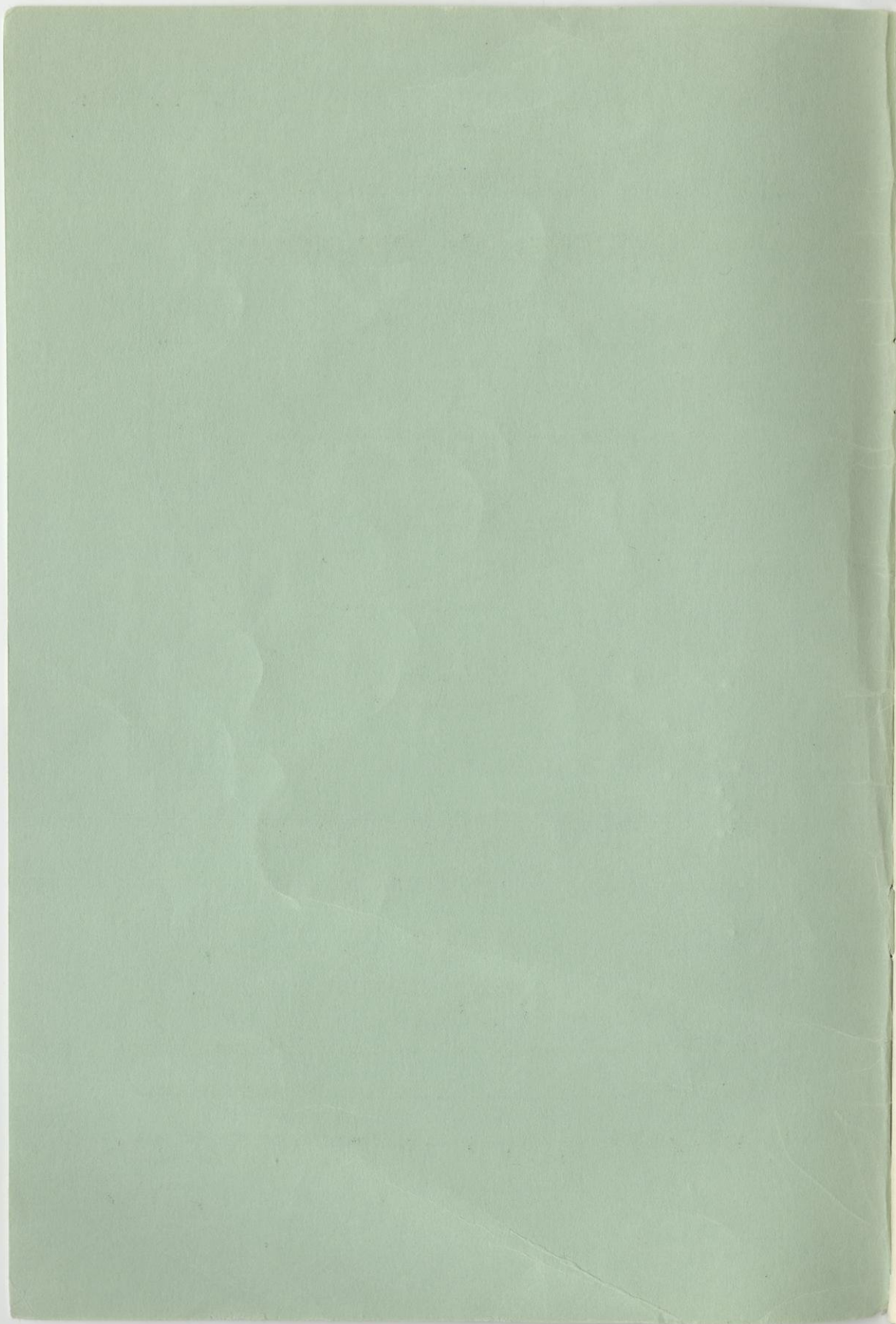

PREVIEW 1967-68 BASKETBALL SEASON
WISCONSIN STATE UNIVERSITY CONFERENCE

The natural tendency in athletics is to stick with the defending champion because an old sports axiom contends that a champion is just that until someone proves otherwise.

This isn't too difficult as Oshkosh opens defense of the Wisconsin State University Conference basketball championship the Titans salted away last March.

Coach Bob White's cagers won the title with a 14-2 record, and most conference observers--particularly rival coaches--pick the Titans to repeat.

Two principal reasons are the appearance in Oshkosh's lineup again of all-conference performers Ron Hayek and John Lallensack. Hayek finished third in scoring last season, averaging almost 24 points a game. Lallensack averaged 15.5 points a game and bagged 210 rebounds on the season, third best in the conference.

Also back at Oshkosh are lettermen Dale Race, Bruce Miller, Rick Rehm, Mike Malone, and Tom Witasek. Add Bill Schwartz, regular pivotman first semester last year who is back, and promising freshmen Ken Roeder and Ken Vergowe. They all add up to a potent basketball team.

Oshkosh remains the team to beat, but from there on the race is wide open. Improvement among last year's "also-rans" should make for a wild scramble among those clubs chasing the Titans.

Superior lost Jim Sevals but still has the conference's best rebounder in Dick Dezur, and Eau Claire should be strong again despite the loss of Stan Johnson, the conference's scoring king and most valuable player.

Mike Grainger leads a group of experienced returnees at La Crosse, and Coach Dick Wadewitz counts on improved team speed to shore up Platteville's defense.

Paul Kulig, fourth best scorer in the conference and second high in rebounds, and John Wolf could boost River Falls into a contending role.

Stevens Point's size, physical strength, and strong rebounding will make Coach Bob Krueger's cagers a problem for any opponent.

Stout lost considerable talent due to graduation and ineligibility but still could surprise, while Whitewater is banking on newcomers in a rebuilding campaign.

Bill Zorn, dean of conference coaches, is starting his 40th season at Eau Claire. New coaches this year include Phil Hey at La Crosse, Newman Benson at River Falls, and Fritz Plinke at Whitewater.
