Upon motion of Regent Renk, seconded by Regent Wanvig, it was
VOTED, That the minutes of the postponed regular meeting of the Board
held on October 16, 1954, be approved as sent out to the Regents.

President Fred read the following paragraph from a letter which he had
received from Dean C. H. Ruedisili, Chairman of the University United Givers Cam-
paign, expressing his personal appreciation to President Fred and the one hundred
and thirteen University solicitors for their energy, cooperation and interest in
putting the University Campaign "over the top":

"I am happy to report that the University has exceeded its quota
this year for the United Givers Campaign. Our quota was \$28,000
and at the close of the campaign last night we had collected
\$29,048.80. This amounts to 103.7% of the quota."

Upon motion of Regent Renk, seconded by Regent Laird, the above report of the Vice President of Business and Finance was approved, ratified and confirmed.

The Vice President of Business and Finance presented the report of budget transfers for October, 1954, for the information of the Regents. (EXHIBIT C attached)

Vice President Peterson reminded the Regents that their December meeting, scheduled for December 11, 1954, will be held in Milwaukee in order that they may inspect the facilities of the Milwaukee Extension Center, and stated that he assumed that each Regent will make his own hotel reservations.

Regent Gelatt presented the report of the Educational Committee.

Upon motion of Regent Gelatt, seconded by Regent Laird, it was VOTED, That the following recommendations of the Educational Committee be adopted:

1. That Howard K. Beale, professor of history, be granted leave of absence, without pay, for the second semester of 1954-55.
2. That Ray Andrews Brown be appointed Jackson Professor of Law for the second semester of 1954-55; salary to be paid as follows: \$5,068.34 charged to 1-B Instruction, \$331.66 charged to Jackson Trust Fund; total, \$5,400. (No change in amount of salary shown in the 1954-55 budget.)
3. That F. H. Elwell, Dean of the School of Commerce, be granted leave of absence on the summer session basis for a period beginning Janu-

ary 6, 1955 and ending March 31, 1955; salary of \$3,252.68 for the period to be distributed \$1,016.66 to Summer Session Trust Fund, \$2,236.02 to the School of Commerce, 1A-1B; saving of \$1,016.66 to be credited to School of Commerce 1A-1B budget.

Upon motion of Regent Gelatt, seconded by Regent Watson, it was VOTED, That the resignation of Henry Ladd Smith, Professor of Journalism, be accepted to take effect at the close of the first semester of 1954-55. (Professor Smith has accepted a position as Director, School of Communications, University of Washington.)

Regent Jones presented the report of the Business and Finance Committee.

Upon motion of Regent Jones, seconded by Regent Renk, it was VOTED, That the Wisconsin Union be authorized to install milk vending machines in such locations in University buildings as are approved by the University administration.

Regent Jones moved and Regent Wanvig seconded the motion for the adoption of the following recommendation of the Business and Finance Committee:

"That upon the recommendation of the Director of Athletics authority be granted to employ architects and engineers to make preliminary studies of possibilities for enlarging the seating capacity of Camp Randall Stadium, the cost of such studies to be charged to the 5-C Intercollegiate Athletics Revolving Fund, and that subject to the approval of the Governor and the State Chief Engineer the Vice President of Business and Finance be authorized to sign agreements which may be required with outside architects and engineers for this study."

Regent Renk suggested that before the present stadium is enlarged consideration be given to the feasibility of moving the stadium farther out into the country where adequate parking facilities could be provided. After some discussion of the advantages and disadvantages of this proposal, Regent Jones moved that the motion be amended to include the clause "the study to include consideration of additional parking facilities needed in connection with athletic events and other University functions." The motion to amend was seconded by Regent Laird. The question was put on the amendment and it was voted, Regent Arveson voting "No". The question was then put on the original motion, as amended, and it was

VOTED, That upon the recommendation of the Director of Athletics authority be granted to employ architects and engineers to make preliminary studies of possibilities for enlarging the seating capacity of Camp Randall Stadium, the study to include consideration of additional parking facilities needed in connection with athletic events and other University functions, the cost of such studies to be charged to the 5-C Intercollegiate Athletics Revolving Fund, and that subject to the approval of the Governor and the State Chief Engineer the Vice President of Business and Finance be authorized to sign agreements which may be required with outside architects and engineers for this study. (Regent Arveson voted "No".)

Upon motion of Regent Renk, seconded by Regent Arveson, it was VOTED, That the Campus Planning Commission study the feasibility of constructing a new stadium in a new location before the present stadium is enlarged.

Upon motion of Regent Jones, seconded by Regent Renk, it was VOTED, That the Rules and Regulations for the Management, Administration and Regulation of Land and Property Owned or Controlled by the University of Wisconsin prescribed by the Regents on September 12, 1953, be amended to include the following additions to Section 7.354 of the said Rules and Regulations:

Sub-paragraphs "r" and "s" of Section 7.354 are created to read:

- r. All eastbound and westbound traffic on Linden Drive shall come to a full stop at the intersection with Babcock Drive.
- s. All eastbound traffic on Linden Drive extended shall come to a full stop at the intersection with Elm Drive.

Upon motion of Regent Jones, seconded by Regent Renk, it was VOTED, That the Vice President of Business and Finance be authorized to sign an agreement between the Regents of the University and Carl Bernard, Madison, for leasing of the boathouse concession at the University Boathouse for the period beginning November 1, 1954, and ending October 31, 1955, on the same terms and conditions as for the 1953-54 season.

Upon motion of Regent Jones, seconded by Regent Laird, it was
VOTED, That the President of the University be authorized to sign a lease and rental agreement with the City of Racine for the continued use of the school building located on the northwest corner of Seventh Street and Lake Avenue, Racine, Wisconsin, for the purpose of operating a University Extension Center for a term commencing October 18, 1954 and ending October 17, 1957, at an annual rental of one dollar, subject to the conditions that the lease and agreement may be terminated by either party on June 30 of any year by written notice 60 days in advance, and that the lease and agreement is automatically terminated on June 30 of any year if legislative appropriations are insufficient to permit the operation of the Racine Extension Center or if the Legislature enacts legislation concerning higher education in Wisconsin which involves a fundamental change in the University's Extension Center program.

VOTED, That upon the recommendation of the Dean of the College of Letters and Science and the Chairman of the School of Music not to exceed \$200 be allotted from the income of the Anonymous Fund to be used in payment of travel expenses of Professor Leo J. Steffens to confer with Robert Casadesus at Princeton, New Jersey.

Upon motion of Regent Renk, seconded by Regent Arveson, it was
VOTED, That a letter signed by the President of the Board be sent to Mr. Clarke Smith, Secretary, extending the best wishes of the Board for his speedy recovery.

Upon motion of Regent Arveson, seconded by Regent Renk, it was
VOTED, That the meeting adjourn.
