STATISTICS

Two hundred thirty-two artists submitted three hundred and fifty-seven works of art in oil and tempera, watercolor, pastel, sculpture, and graphics, with a limit of two entries per person.

Eighty-one works were selected by the jury for exhibition in the Salon. Represented in this selection are the works of sixty-nine Wisconsin artists.

The contributors who were eligible have had three years of residence in Wisconsin including the past year, or were ten year residents in Wisconsin if now living outside the state, or are students or instructors now attending Wisconsin art schools.

THE AWARDS

The jury has selected those works it considers as especially worthy of purchase. In doing so it has considered all works entered in the exhibition including those not available for purchase prizes.
