I want you to turn out all East Hampton — the rich and poor — old and young — male and female and I was going to say black and white —. You must do all you can to help it along. If those young bloods boarding at Mrs Millers are in town you must make them come! as this is the first of the season we want something rich. "So go it while you are young for when you get old you cant". If you come down before Wednesday give us a call. Excuse this as I am in a D—l of a hurry —
