RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE PRESIDENT

-General-

Research

1. That in accordance with the recommendations of the university research committee the following allotments be made from the University Research fund:

RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE BUSINESS MANAGER

The Business Manager presented the offer of a proposed site for the Door County Demonstration Station for the sum of \$15,500. It was

VOTED, That the proposal be approved subject to advice from the Attorney-General to be obtained by the Business Manager.

The Business Manager made verbal report on the financial situation in the University Extension Division.

The Business Manager reported upon the matter of securing funds for the

REMODELING OF CHADBOURNE HALL,

stating that pursuant to the former recommendation of the Regents he had endeavored to finance the required improvements by funds chargeable to maintenance but had been unsuccessful in getting the state authorities to assent to charging more than a limited portion of the expense to that account. He further advised that the only other method by which the University could finance the improvements would be from maintenance (to a limited part of the expense) and the remainder from savings in operation under Sections 20.41(8) and 36.065, and that before drawing on the balance in operation the assent of the Governor would be required; whereupon, after discussion of the situation, the following resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, the Industrial Commission has reported that certain changes should be made in Chadbourne Hall in order to reduce the present fire hazards which changes will cost, as estimated, approximately \$23,000.00.

AND WHEREAS, the Regents have no means (except to a limited part of such expense) of financing the same excepting by drawing on the savings in operation, and the consent of the Governor is required before such accounts can be drawn upon;

AND WHEREAS, the Regents admit that it is of the utmost importance that the recommended changes be made and completed as promptly as possible;

RESOLVED, that the Business Manager be instructed to present the matter to the Governor, and to obtain from him the necessary assent to use the capital account and savings in operation so far as may be required to make and complete the recommended changes.

The Business Manager was authorized to remodel the elevator in Science Hall, in accordance with the recommendation of the Industrial Commission.

The President presented letters from O. ^E~~B~~. Remy and others, requesting the university to make an exhibit at the State Fair. The matter was referred to the Business Manager.

The Secretary reported that there was \$20,000 of funds in the

available for investment.
