The deed from you to
Arthur Cominy is dated 12 Jan'y 1871.
Gardiner's judgment against you
was obtained in 1868 and was
consequently a lien on all the
property conveyed by that deed.
In 1873 the Sheriff sold & conveyed
to Cleveland Gardiner the land with
the buildings thereon bounded North
by Amagansette Road, South by land
of H. S. Roscoe, East by land of Albert
Hedges & West by the road to the
Ocean containing $2\frac{1}{2}$ acres.
The Trustees of Mountauk

also had judgments against you
obtained prior to the deed to
Arthur & under one of these they
sold, bought in, on January 17, 1871
"the piece of land with the mill thereon
"known as the Hook Mill lot
"bounded North Easterly by the Hook
"burying ground or cemetery, South
"South Easterly & North Westerly by
"highways containing three quarters
"of an acre" they also sold bought
in a tract of 16 acres known as
"Lily Hill Cove"

I think you have all the
facts now & can form your own
opinion. If Gardiner's purchase
covers the Mill lot he has the
title if not it is in the Trustees
of Montauk.
