A Treaty of Peace and Trembship make and concluded between William black, runan Edwards and Auguste Choutean Commispioners Plenepotentiary of the United States of America on the part and behalf of the said States of the one part; and the undersigned Chiefs & warriors representing eight band of Lionas composing the three Tribes catted the Lionas of the Leg the Lionas of the Broad Leaf and the Lionas who thoot in the Pinely on the part and behalf of their said hibes of the other part. The Parties heing desirous of reestablishing Peace & Friendship between the United Hates and the said Tribes, and of being plante all things and in every respect on the same footing upon which they stood before the war between the until thates and Great Britain have agreed to the following Articles. All, I. Every inpury or act of hostility committed by our or either of the contracting has for the other that he mutually forguen and forgot. Art; 11. Then whalf be perpetual Peau & Friendship between all the Colitiseus of the United thates and all the intividuals com: - posing the aforesaid Tribes; and all the printly relations that existed between them before the war shall be and the same are herety renewed. Att; 111. The underrigued Chiefs & warriors for thurselies and their Tribes respectively do by these Presents, confirm to the limited States, all and every tepron or copious of land heretofore made by their Trobes to the British trench or Tpanish Government, within the limits of the united states or their Territories; and the Parties here contracting, do morrower in the sincerity of mutual printship, suggisting rustellish and confirm, all and every trest contract and agreement heretofour concluded between the mited thates and the said Tribes or rations. Art IV. The undersigned Chiefs & warniors as aforesaid, for themselves and their said hibes, do herby secretary, restellist acknowledge
