I find that I bought

45 Duane St. N.Y. a pair of Burr
millstone and an old fashioned
Burr mill for crushing Corn & cobs

Now I understand the Foundry
is still there, and if so perhaps
you have the old pattern and
can furnish me a crusher
that will fit the frame I have
used constantly for 42 years and am
using it now. It has without
doubt crushed 50,000 bushels, but
is worn out now.
