## Exiting NLS

There is no formal logoff procedure to exit from NLS. On any NLS screen enter the command:

exit

This returns you to the University of Wisconsin Main Menu. From here you select the option to quit by either entering the function key assigned or pressing your tab key until the curser reaches the QUIT option, then press ENTER. You are exited from the tn3270 or telnet application.
