February, 1979 - Correspondence

Received letter from PD, a member of St. Mary's Orthodox Church in Cornucopia. He wrote to me in response to my request (in newspapers) for songs or hymns of early settlers.

May 15, 1979 - Telephone

Sara Poynter called PD regarding an interview appointment. He explained that this week was not convenient for him because of church business. He seemed willing to be interviewed in a few weeks.

June 7, 1979 - Telephone

PD called me at home, asking if I was still interested in hearing the Russian hymns. We arranged to meet the next morning at the 10:30 Sunday service.

June 10, 1979 - Unrecorded Interview

I went to St. Mary's Orthodox Church in Cornucopia and sat in on the last 15 minutes of their service. After church, we went to PD's house. Off and on during the interview, his neighbor NC stopped by to talk with us.

June 26, 1979 - Telephone

PD called me at home, asking if Grant and I were coming to the service July 1st. Asked me if I wanted to practice with choir Thursday night. I declined due to a prior commitment.

June 28, 1979 - Correspondence

Received postcard from PD reminding us of "divine liturgy" on Sunday.

July 1, 1979 - Recorded Service

I went to St. Mary's Orthodox Church with my husband, my parents and my Ukranian friend. Recorded entire service except the sermon at PD's suggestion.
