HISTORY:

On June 25, 1910, about 8 p.m., she caught fire and burned to the water's edge at Bad Axe Island in the Mississippi River and sank near Victory, Wisconsin. Reports vary as to how many passengers were on board, 1185, 1219, 1500, but only two were lost. She was bound from LaCrosse, Wisconsin, to Lansing, Iowa.
