On the return trip the *Christopher Columbus* leaves Milwaukee (East Water Street bridge) at 5 p. m. (4 p. m.

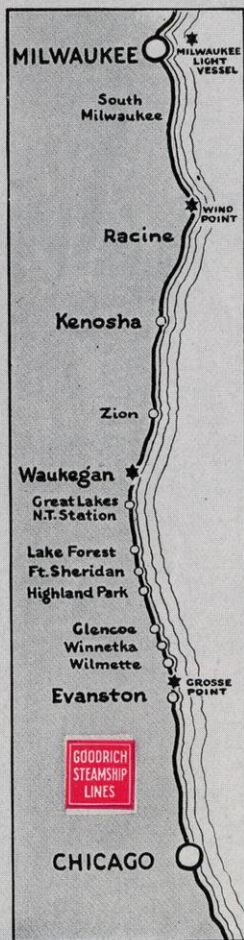
Milwaukee city time), daily except Saturday.

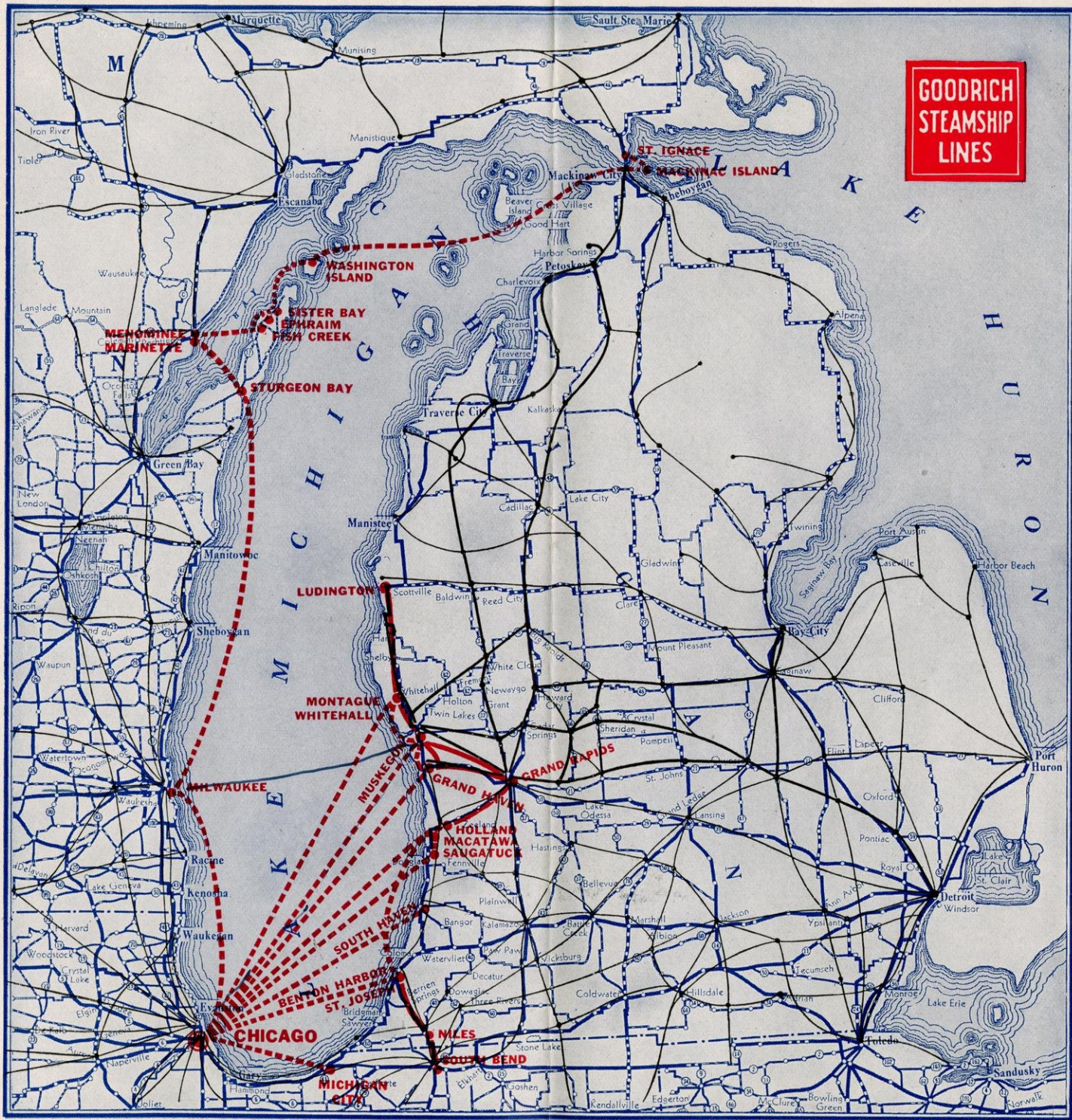
