



2008 Art Department Faculty Exhibition

January 26 to March 30, 2008 |

Periodically, the Chazen Museum of Art hosts an exhibition that showcases the work of the UW–Madison art department faculty, who not only teach but actively pursue their own art. The exhibition, which fills three temporary exhibition galleries as well as the entire fourth floor, is as diverse and innovative as the faculty and the art world at large. Paintings, sculpture, graphics, ceramics, textiles, woodwork, metalwork, glass, prints, and photographs, as well as performance, video, and computer art, will all be on view. The styles, media, and techniques seen at the finest national and international art shows are seen in the art department works. This year, twenty-seven current faculty, seven affiliates from related departments and Tandem Press, and seventeen emeritus faculty will display their latest creative pieces. The exhibition will be held from January 26–March 30, 2008.

The mission of the UW–Madison Art Department is to provide high-quality educational opportunities to students planning careers as professional visual artists and art educators as well as to offer programs for developing a visually literate community. This community exhibition is an outstanding expression of that commitment: for art students, seeing professors' professional work affords an understanding of the ways in which classroom activities are directly linked to creative practice. For the rest of the community on and off campus, the group show provides access to work that is produced here but most often seen elsewhere, nationally and internationally. The gallery talks by faculty members scheduled throughout the run of the exhibition extend the teaching dimension of the exhibition to audiences who are not students in the formal classroom sense.

The museum is located on the campus of the University of Wisconsin–Madison and is accessible to wheelchairs from the north entrance (nearest to Library Mall). An elevator is down the corridor to the right.
