

To Menry & Pagliston of Revraine Greeting.

For being of pointed Adjulunt of the Reventh Regiment

of the Militia of this State, and reposing special trust and confidence in your patriotism, valour and good conduct,—I do, by virtue of these presents, in the name and by the authority of the Freemen of the State of Vermont, fully authorize and empower you the said Regiment to take charge of the said Regiment as their Activities.

**Xou will,** therefore, carefully and diligently discharge the said duty, by doing and performing every matter and thing thereunto relating. You will observe and follow such orders and directions as you shall from time to time, receive from the Commander in Chief, for the time being, or any other your superior Officer, according to military discipline and the laws of this State. And all officers and soldiers under your command are to take notice hereof, and yield due obedience to your orders, as their Achieved in pursuance of the trust in you reposed.

In testimony whereof, I have caused the seal of this state to be hereunto affixed.


